

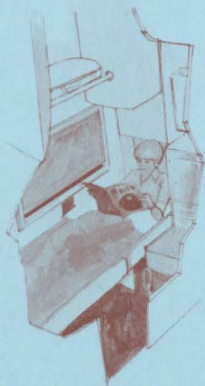
# Amtrak makes it easier to take

The Railroad industry has **traveling** always been proud of the unique sleeping accommodations they could offer passengers on long-distance trains • Now, **lying down**

Amtrak announces the arrival of the all electric sleeping cars operating on some of the long-distance routes served by Amfleet equipment • When Amfleet trains were first introduced into service, there were no sleeping cars. Amtrak wanted its passengers to have the option of a sleeping car over coach travel, so our designers went to work and converted some of our conventional sleepers into newly refurbished electric sleepers compatible with the all electric Amfleet trains • Amtrak believes passengers should be able to take train traveling lying down if they so wish. Passengers will be able to reserve both roomettes or bedrooms on the routes now equipped with these converted sleepers.



**For passengers unfamiliar with sleeping car travel, here's a brief description of the service we offer on our long-distance routes:**



### **Slumbercoach\***

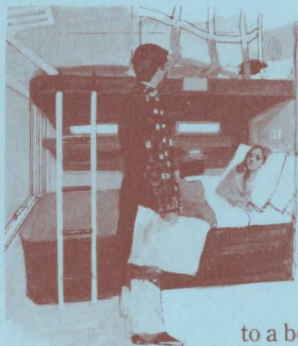
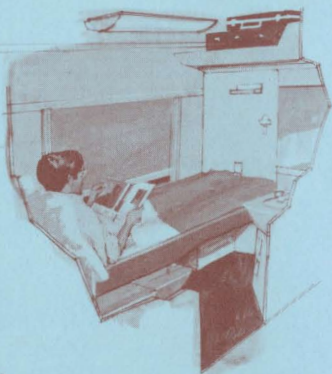
Our Slumbercoaches have lounge seats that convert to comfortable beds. Single rooms in Slumbercoach have fold-away beds.

Doubles have upper and lower beds. Each room has a private washstand and toilet facilities.

### **Roomette**

A private room for individual travelers. Larger than a Slumbercoach. The roomette is equipped with a comfortable seat, fold-down bed, private toilet and washbasin.



### **Bedrooms**

A bedroom is more spacious than a roomette and is ideal for two people. It has two separate berths for sleeping, and a private toilet and washbasin facilities. On some of our routes Amtrak has drawing rooms. Although similar

to a bedroom, a drawing room is substantially larger and provides

three separate berths for sleeping, in addition to a private toilet and washbasin facilities.

### **The Superliners Are Coming!**

When put into service, the Superliners, will offer a wide selection of sleeping car accommodations including a family economy room which sleeps up to three adults and two children; a deluxe bedroom accommodating two adults and a child; an economy sleeper suitable for two adults; and a special room for a handicapped passenger and a companion. Now, try to take that lying down!
