Seattle—Los Angeles (Superliner Service)

Checked Baggage—Handled at all stations **except** East Olympia, Kelso—Longview, Chemult, Dunsmuir, Redding, Chico, Marysville, Richmond and Simi Valley. Baggage checked through to or from points south of Los Angeles or baggage checked to Los Angeles to be claimed prior to boarding trains 14 and 586 may be subject to delay. Passengers transferring at Seattle to Vancouver, BC connecting bus must carry their baggage on board the train.

Express bus service (connecting with Amtrak trains at Seattle station) to/from downtown Vancouver, BC. Trailways Northwest (604) 875–1307.















Seattle—Victoria, BC

Clipper Navigation *M.V. Victoria Clipper* high-speed ship service year around. Ship sails from Seattle Pier 69, 1 mile from Amtrak station and docks in Victoria's Inner Harbor. (206) 443–2567.

Salinas—Monterey

Services between Salinas Amtrak Station (no connection from train 14 on Sunday) and Monterey. Pay fare on bus. Monterey—Salinas Transit (408) 899–2555.
