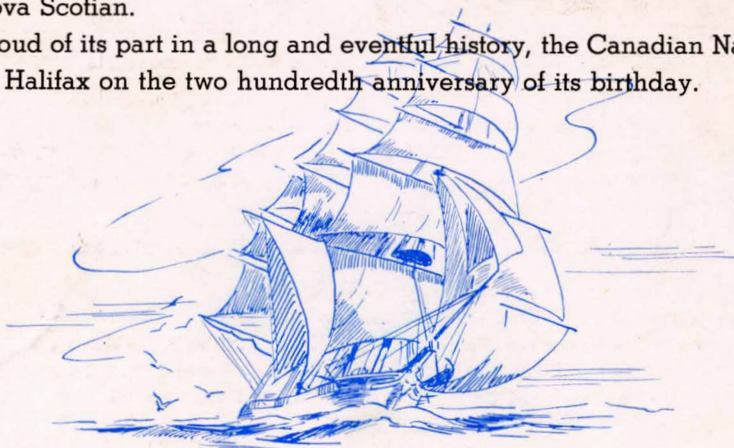


Bicentenary of Halifax

Two centuries ago this summer, thirteen ships, escorted by a sloop of war, dropped anchor in Chebucto Bay on the southern shore of Nova Scotia. The passengers were more than 2,500 men, women and children, the first English settlers brought out to Canada. Under the leadership of Edward Cornwallis, the newly appointed Governor of Nova Scotia, they hewed down trees on the shore of the bay—now known as one of the great harbors of the world—and laid the foundations for the city of Halifax, a city destined to grow in importance with every passing decade.

The Canadian National System has been associated with that development for nearly a hundred years and it continues to serve the city and port with railway, steamships, air lines and one of its finest hotels, The Nova Scotian.

Proud of its part in a long and eventful history, the Canadian National salutes Halifax on the two hundredth anniversary of its birthday.
