Land of FAR HORIZONS

From the border of Ontario to the mountain hem of British Columbia, from the United States boundary to Hudson Bay and the beginning of the North West Territories, the three western provinces of Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta spread out over nearly a million square miles. This is the land of the great plains, the level prairie, rippling into a gentle swell westward until it breaks in foothills against the Rockies. This is the land of grain, whose sundrenched acres yield every year hundreds of millions of bushels of wheat, oats, rye and barley. It is the land, too, of far-spreading cattle ranges, the land of gold, copper and zinc, of oil and coal, the land of fur. The development of this vast and rich territory, now populated by nearly two and a half million people, was made possible by the railways. Not so many years ago, it was known only to buffalo herds, bands of roaming Indians, and the few hardy explorers and fur traders who travelled by canoe, on horseback or in the ox-powered Red River cart. Today the lines of the Canadian National Railways cover the three provinces with a web of steel and the fruits of the western plains and woodlands go out to the markets of the world.
