When you're in Jasper, don't fail to motor to the Columbia Icefield. The picture of Mount Athabaska on the cover of this menu will give you an idea of its impressiveness. The largest body of ice between the Arctic and the Antarctic regions, covering an area of more than 110 square miles, it is justifiably known as one of the Wonders of the World. The name "Mother of Rivers" is apt, too, because from its glaciers spring streams that develop into great rivers and run into three oceans. Guests at the mountain chalet at the foot of Mount Athabaska ride horseback over the ice and even ski on the eternal snow, enjoying January in July.
