*"Meat, for thy health's sake"*

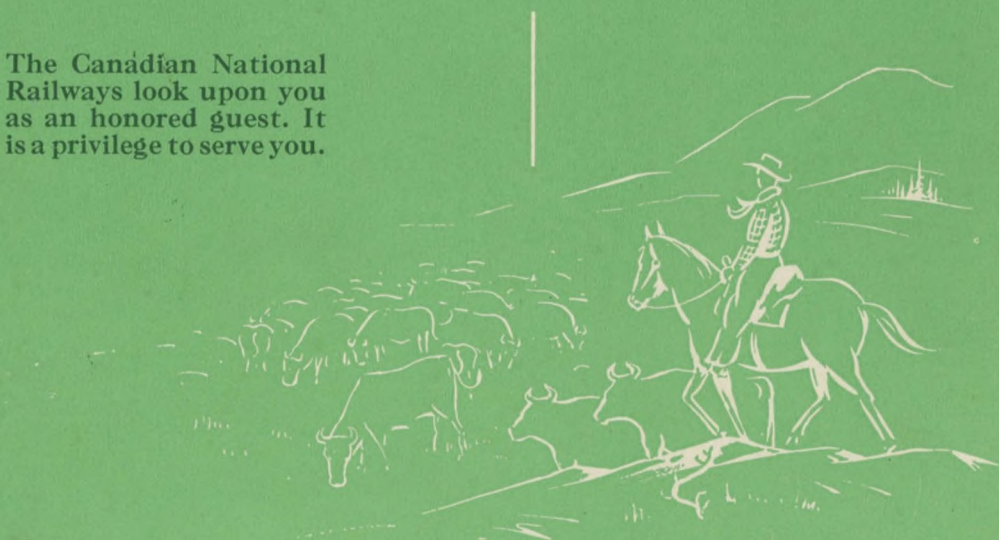
