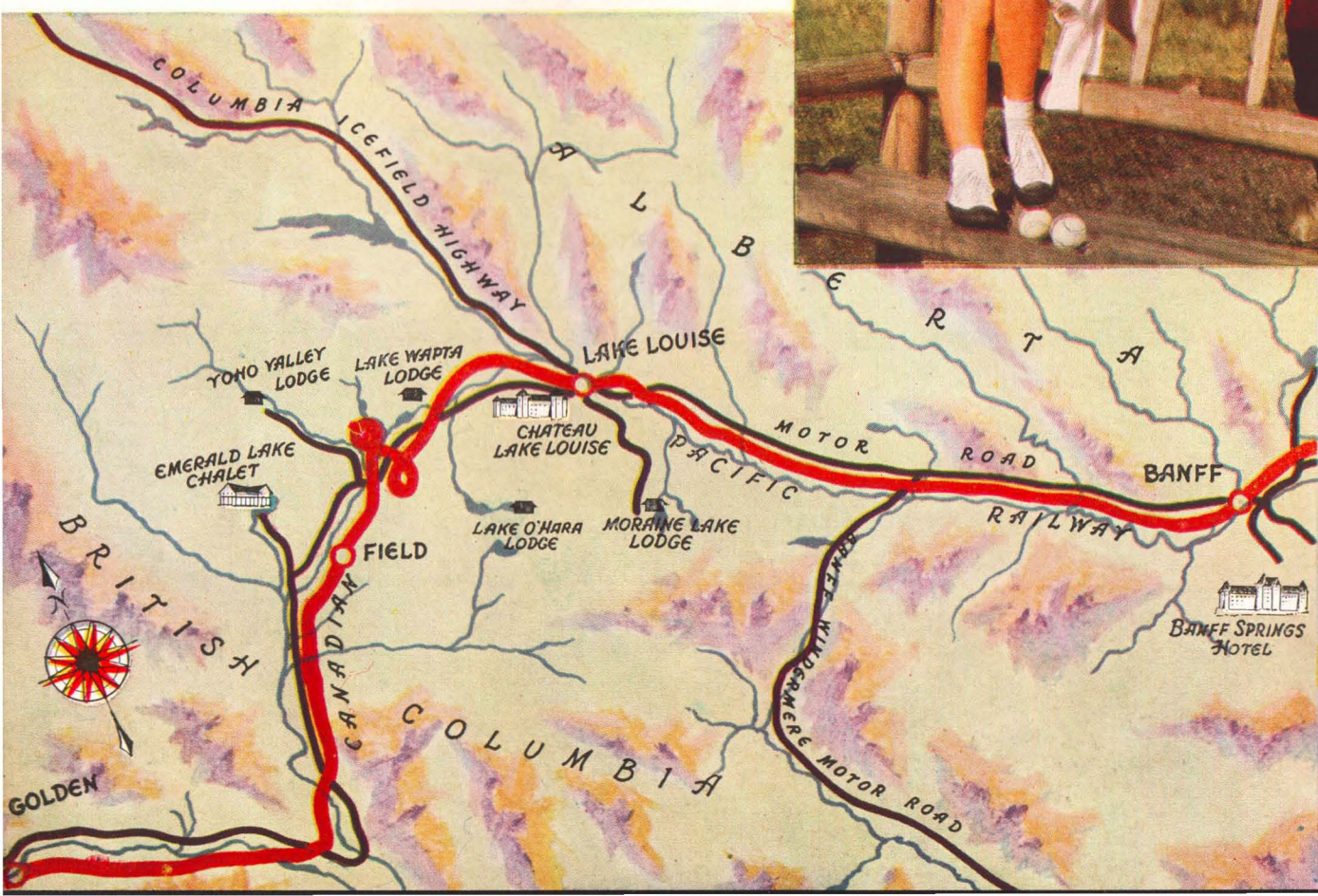

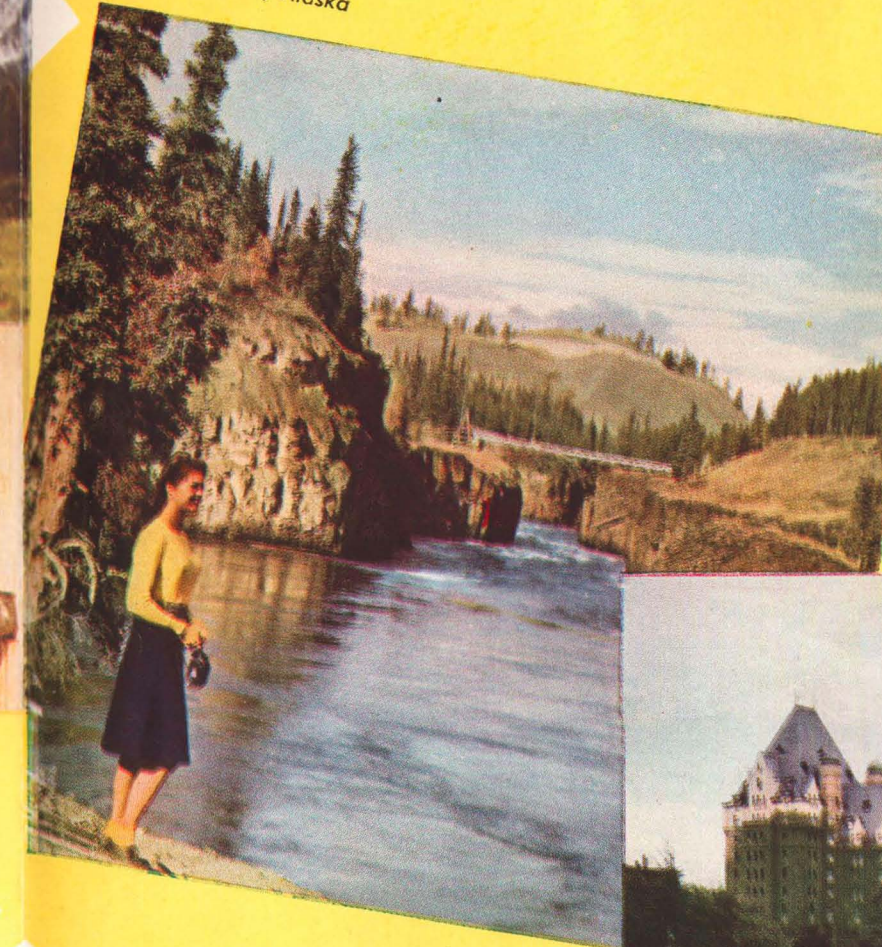


The Spiral Tunnels, shown between Field and Lake Louise are the scene of the cover picture.

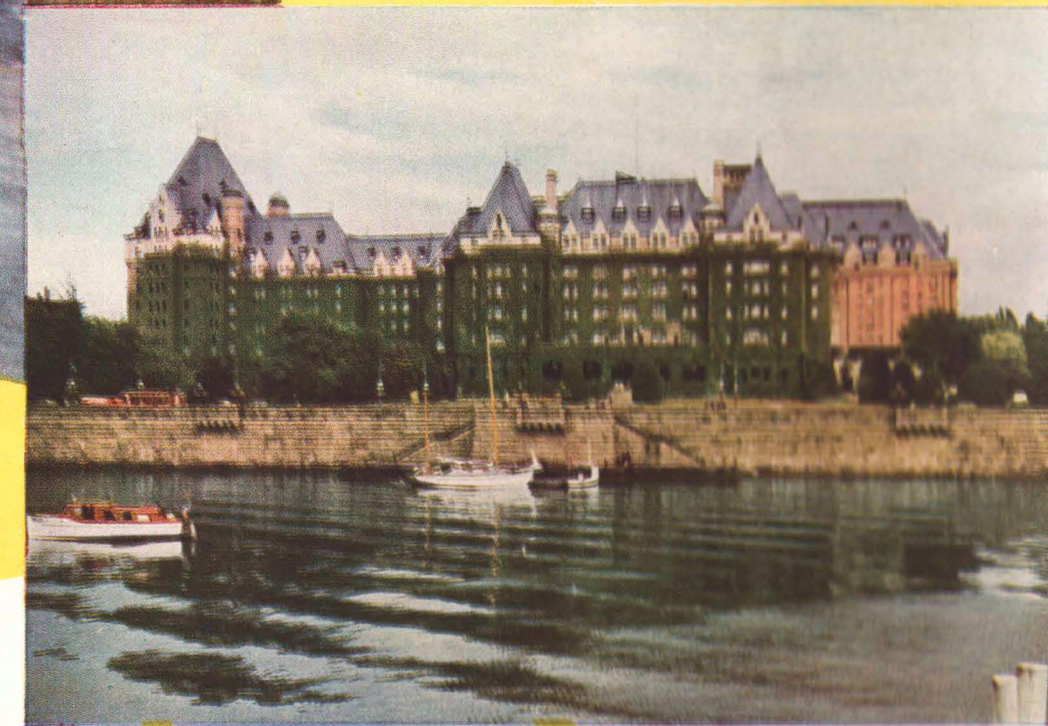

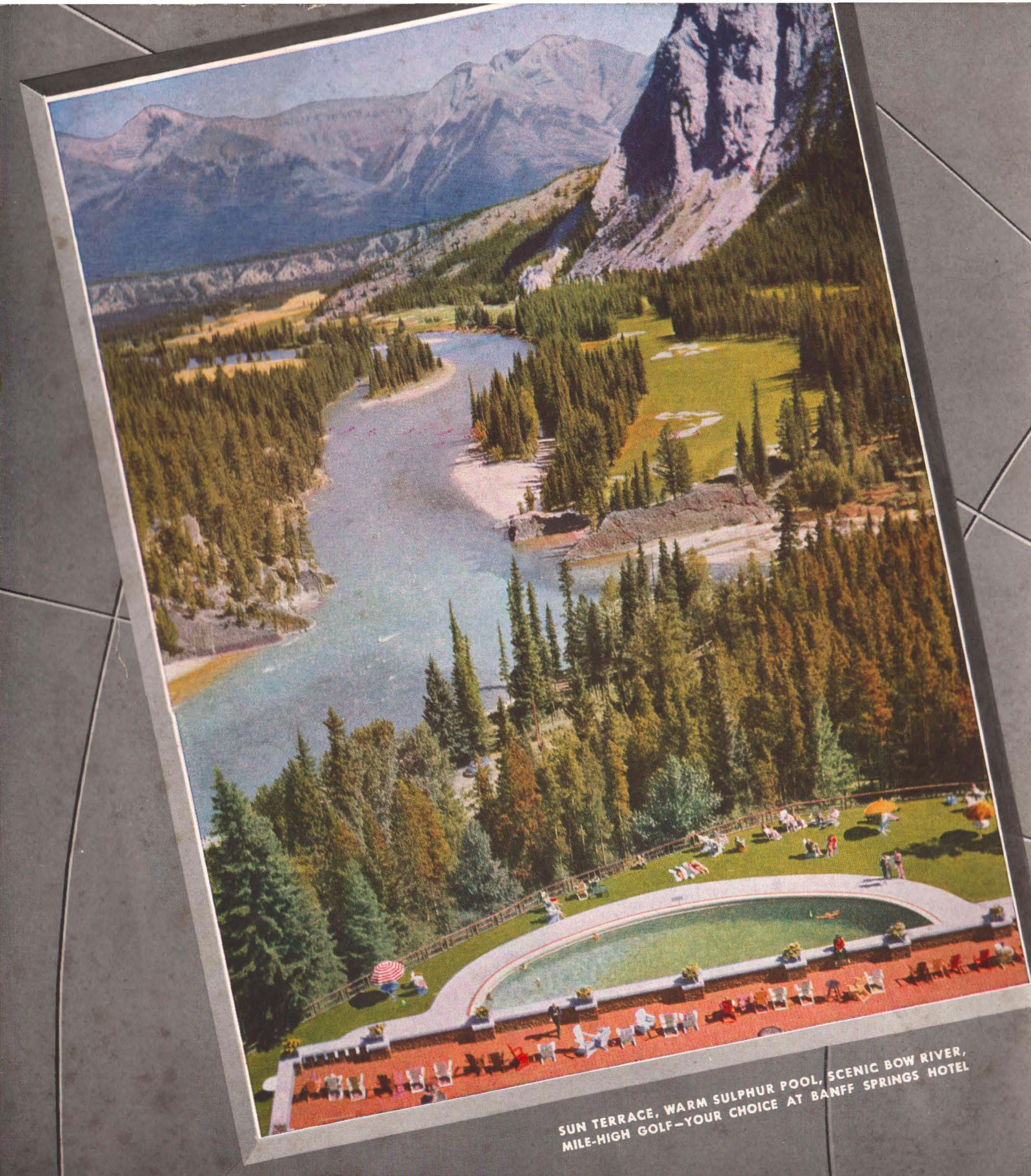


Your Canadian holiday can be as
