Toronto

Toronto—in the Huron tongue, "a place of meeting"—capital of Ontario, typifies the province it serves.

Busy, bustling, progressive, this lake port and rail centre is the focal point of manufacturing, mining, trading, banking, the arts and travel in central Canada.

Toronto's harbour, sheltered by a chain of islands, a tribute to engineering skill, is built on reclaimed land traversed by the six-lane boulevard pictured (at a quiet moment) on the cover. Close to docks and the Union Station, the Canadian Pacific Royal York Hotel is a social and commercial centre that dominates the downtown sky-line and overlooks Lake Ontario.

Toronto as a travel centre links the North American continent with Georgian Bay, French River, the Muskoka and Kawartha Lakes, Niagara Falls, the north shore of Lake Superior and other notable hunting, fishing and holiday areas.
