## Peggy Cove

Not far from Halifax and one of the most picturesque spots on the picturesque coast-line of Nova Scotia is Peggy Cove, a tiny fishing inlet beloved of artists. Peggy Cove typifies sea-girt Nova Scotia in its work-a-day life as a bountiful producer of deep-sea fish. Lobster pots stacked on timbered wharves, fishing nets drying in the sun or under repair by the nimble fingers of tanned fishermen, gaily coloured marker buoys, sturdy power boats-blend into scenes worthy of the many canvasses upon which they are depicted.
Back drops for this coast-born beauty are wave-smoothed rocks and the silver grey of shingled buildings weathered to an incredible mellowness by ozone-filled breezes and brilliant summer suns.
Three Canadian Pacific hotels in Nova ScotiaCornwallis Inn, Kentville, The Digby Pines at Digby, Lakeside Inn at Yarmouth, give access by good motor roads to Nova Scotia's scenic treasures.
