All checked baggage is transported by passenger train and made available for prompt delivery at destination.

EXPRESS SHIPPING FACILITIES. A representative of the Canadian Pacific Express Company will be on the Pier at Montreal for the benefit of passengers desiring to forward shipments by Express to any point in Canada or to certain points in the United States.

CANADIAN AND U.S.A. PASSPORT INSPECTION

IMPORTANT—This notice applies to every passenger.

It is expected that the ship will arrive at FATHER POINT about 5-00 a.m. Thursday and QUEBEC about 2-00 p.m. Thursday.

Immigration Officials will board the ship at Father Point, and it is anticipated that examination will commence about 8-00 a.m.

EXAMINATION OF PASSENGERS FOR CANADA

(a) CANADIAN CITIZENS will be examined first, and are requested to assemble outside the Forward end of the Lounge with Vaccination Certificates and Passports in readiness, when called for over the Public Address System.

(b) Other passengers for Canada (holding Landing Cards numbered 1 to 63) will follow when advised to do so over the Public Address System, taking Landing Cards, Passports, etc. with them.

Passengers are requested NOT to assemble outside the Lounge until their category or Landing Card numbers are announced.

EXAMINATION OF PASSENGERS FOR U.S.A.

ALL PASSENGERS HOLDING UNITED STATES BLUE OR WHITE LANDING CARDS are required to assemble in the EMPRESS ROOM when advised to do so over the Public Address System.

Passengers holding two landing cards (Canadian and U.S.A.) bearing a red line are required to pass both Canadian and American Immigration Officers.

PLEASE LISTEN CAREFULLY FOR ANNOUNCEMENTS

(B) Other passengers for Canada (holding Landing Cards numbered 1 to 45) will follow when advised to do so over the Public Address System taking Landing Cards, Passports, etc. with them.

Passengers are requested NOT to assemble outside the Lounge until their category or Landing Card number are announced.

EXAMINATION OF PASSENGERS FOR U.S.A.

ALL PASSENGERS HOLDING UNITED STATES BLUE OR WHITE LANDING CARDS are requested to assemble in the EMPRESS ROOM when advised to do so over the Public Address System.

Passengers holding two landing cards (Canadian and U.S.A.) bearing a red line are required to pass both Canadian and American Immigration Officers.
