More than a mile high, this limpid lake, fed by mighty Victoria Glacier, its waters fringed by multi-coloured poppies, columbines, violets, anemones, is unrivalled for beauty. Basking in clear, invigorating mountain air as stimulating as sparkling spring water, Chateau Lake Louise, Canadian Pacific hostelry from which this Rocky Mountain beauty is enjoyed, was cunningly sited to make the most of nature's bounty.

Its every window a picture frame, the gracious chateau commands the milky-jade waters of Lake Louise and the snowy peaks of the Pipestone Range. You can enjoy boating, mountain pony riding, swimming in a glass-enclosed open air pool of warmed glacial water, hiking, climbing and dancing. By modern highways from Chateau Lake Louise, mountains, valleys, streams are within easy reach of the motorist. Notable sights and experiences include the Columbia Icefield Highway to the Columbia Icefield. Nearby eight-mile-long Mount Eisenhower was renamed in 1946 for the President as Canada's recognition of General of the Army Eisenhower's service to mankind as Supreme Commander of the Allied Armies in World War II.
