

"SCENIC-DOME" CARS THROUGH SCENIC CANADA IN 1954

Our picture visualizes the new Canadian Pacific all-stainless-steel equipment soon to serve the scenic routes between Montreal and Vancouver and Toronto and Vancouver via the Banff-Lake Louise route through the Canadian Rockies.

First of the 155 streamlined cars in operation will be the "Scenic-Domes" — introduced by Canadian Pacific for the first time on any railroad in Canada. They will be of two types — Observation Sleeping Cars (one drawing room and three double bedrooms) and Buffet Coaches (with 28 overnight fulllength leg-rest seats and a coffee shop). Each upper level "Scenic-Dome" will have 24 seats. Modern overnight coaches with adjustable leg-rest seats; all types of sleeping accommodation, eating and observation facilities will cater to every taste and every purse.
