THE TERRACE Banff Springs Hotel

Banff Springs Hotel, famous Canadian Pacific summer resort at Banff, Alberta, in the heart of the Canadian Rockies, dominates a barony of water-falls. vallevs and mountains. Commandingly sited at the confluence of the Spray and Bow Rivers, the 600 room hotel built of stone quarried from overlooking Mount Rundle is noted as one of the world's finest. Specially equipped for mountain holidays with emphasis on horseback riding, climbing, hiking and golf, Banff is equally notable for the standard holiday amenities of tennis, motoring, swimming, fishing, wild flower rambling and just plain laziness.

One of the ideal spots for the 'just plain lazy' is the Riverview Terrace which might just as well have been called 'Cascade View Terrace,' as a tribute to the aptly-named 9,836 foot mountain which towers over it in the background. Here, flanked by the Red Terrace, the outdoor, warmed, faintly sulphured swimming pool, the rushing Bow Falls and the paddock where tribal sports are carried out by Indians from the nearby Stony Reservation, carefree visitors while away sunny hours.
