YOHO VALLEY

How often has your instinctive remark at the first sight of a spectacular view been 'How wonderful'? It is an expression frequently on the lips of travellers through the Canadian Rockies. That it is justified, even if trite, is evidenced in the name given by the Cree Indians to the magnificent Yoho Valley.

'Yoho' has been translated from the Cree language as 'How wonderful,' and it is generally assumed that to the first Cree who saw this beautiful valley must be given the credit for its name. No better name could have been chosen.

Yoho Valley is first seen by the westbound passenger when the diesel-powered train reaches a level shelf that leads to the famous Spiral Tunnels by which the steep gradient is overcome, and the Valley seems to stretch limitlessly northward from the point where the Yoho River enters the Kicking Horse.

Yoho Valley is within the confines of Yoho National Park, where plant and wild life are protected and guns are forbidden.
