Almost as awe-inspiring as the great Canadian Rockies, the Selkirks and the Coast Range through which the main transcontinental line of the Canadian Pacific Railway passes to link Atlantic and Pacific is the march of progress evidenced by Canada's first dome-equipped allstainless-steel streamliner, "The Canadian".

Already high on the list of the world's most famous trains, "The Canadian", in daily service each way between Montreal-Vancouver and Toronto-Vancouver, has many notable features in addition to the high level scenic domes which it first introduced into Canada. Characterized by flow-through decor, colour harmony and artistic embellishment in an all-Canadian theme, "The Canadian" has been referred to as "a travelling art gallery". Chief claim to this title is the series of murals by members of the Royal Canadian Academy of Arts in the domed lounge observation cars. Other interesting features include etched glass reproductions of Canadian flora and fauna, animated maps of Canada, the unique star-studded ceilings of the dining room cars and a novel use of pastel-tinted plastics in many types of accommodation.

Taking less than three days to travel from Tidewater to Tidewater "The Canadian" offers all types of sleeping accommodation from tourist berths to drawing rooms, deluxe coaches fitted with adjustable reclining seats with full length leg rests, deluxe dining room cars and coffee shops serving economy meals and snacks.
