## CHATEAU FRONTENAC

Typical of the bi-lingual culture of La Province de Québec as the tall, bright spires and colourful cottages that dot the banks of The St. Lawrence, Chateau Frontenac, poised high above Cape Diamond, dominates the ancient walled city of Quebec.

Built by the Canadian Pacific in the style of a sixteenth-century French Chateau as a year-round hotel on the site of the palace of the Governor of New France, its turrets and pinnacles pierce the skyline in a gesture of welcome to the traveller.

Living is truly gracious in the Chateau and from its hospitable portals visitors explore the winding streets of the old city by caleche, find bargains—antique and moderne—play golf, fish or see old-world Ile d'Orleans, Montmorency Falls and the famous shrine of Ste Anne de Beaupré.

In winter Chateau Frontenac is a winter sports centre. Lac Beauport Snow Bowl and the Chateau Ski-Hawk School are popular. There is curling, snow-shoeing, tobogganing, hockey—and, year-round, exquisite cuisine, polished service, true Canadian hospitality.
