



Westerham

Major-General James Wolfe was born at Westerham, Kent, England, in 1727. He became a Major-General at the age of thirty-two. In 1759 he commanded the army which was sent up the St. Lawrence against Quebec and was wounded during the battle on the Plains of Abraham, dying in the hour of victory.

His home, Quebec House at Westerham, was purchased in 1913 and restored by Mr. J. B. Learmont, of Montreal, whose widow presented it, with an endowment, to the National Trust in 1918.
