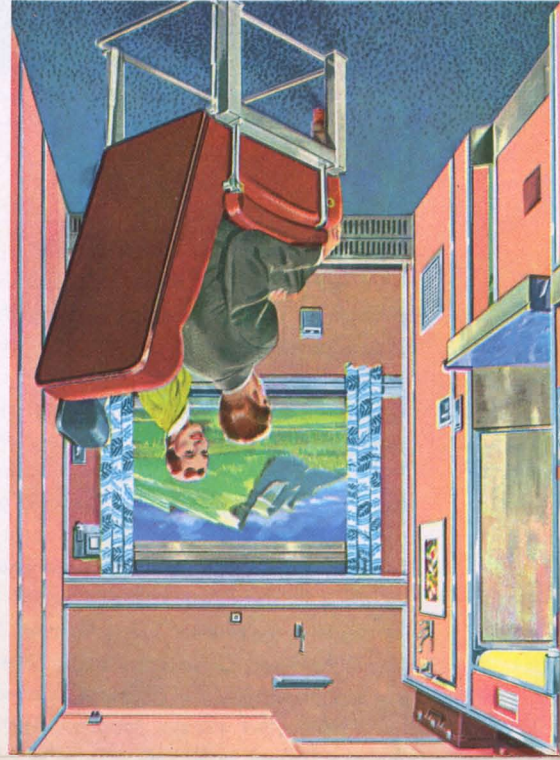

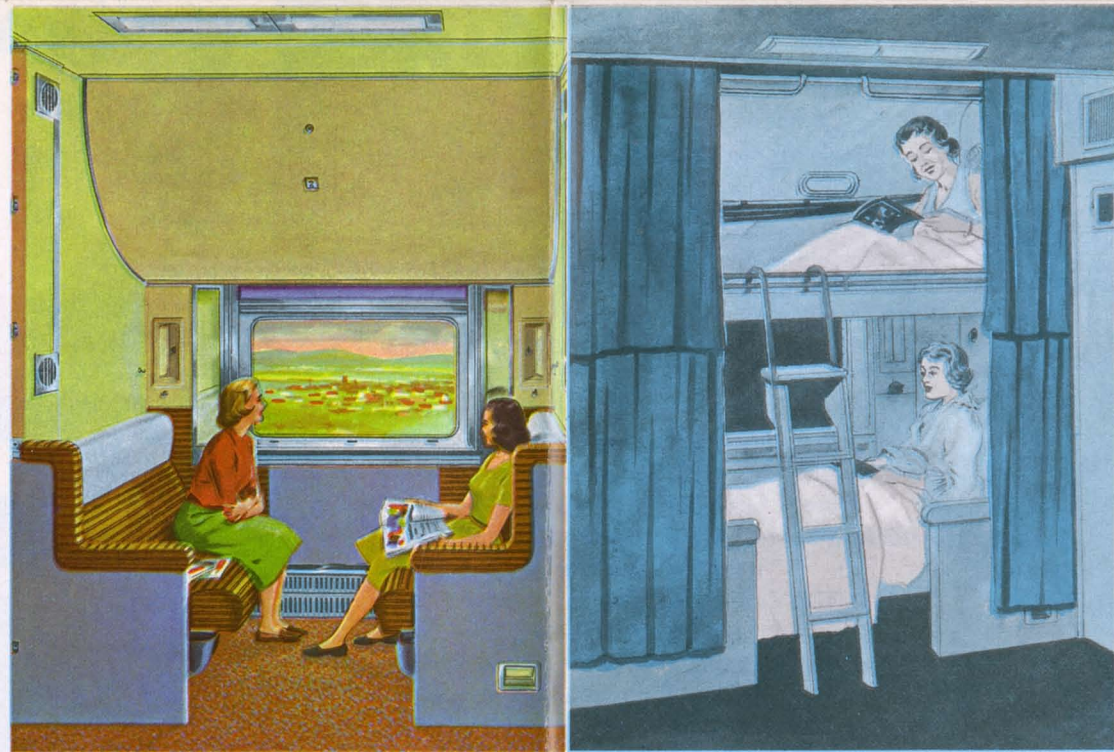


COMPLETE PRIVACY

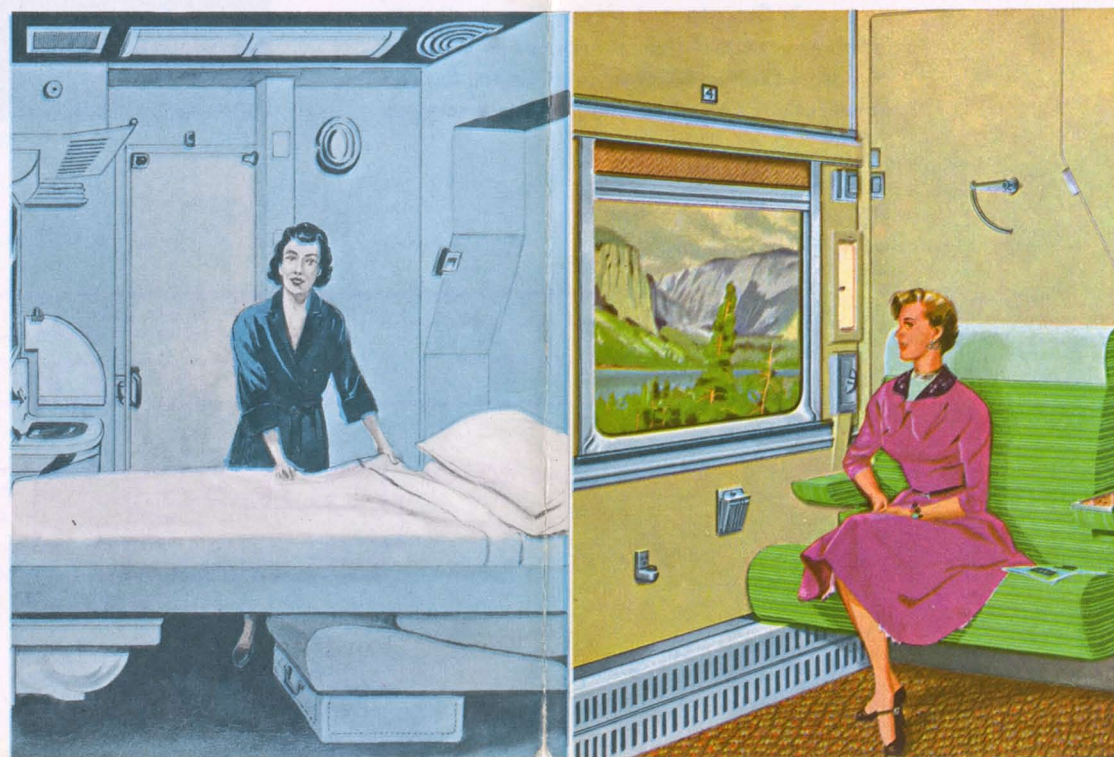

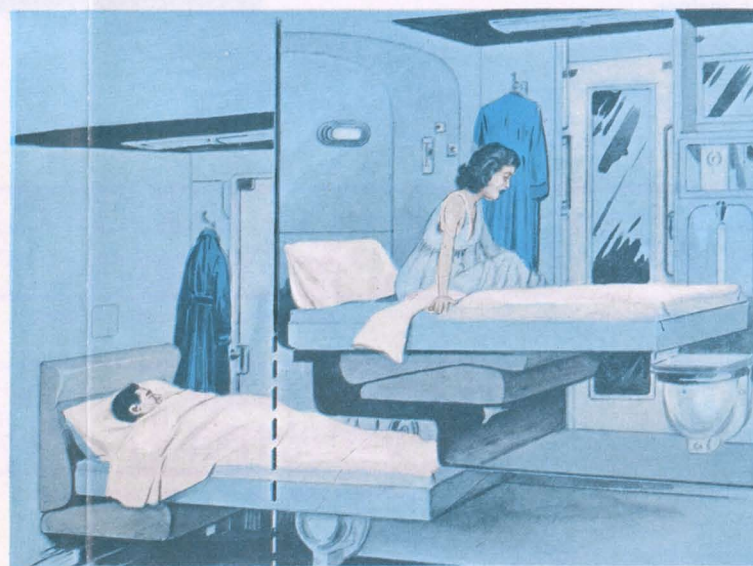
BERTHS — upper and lower berths are two-seated and wide-windowed by day and offer zipper-curtained, air conditioned privacy and complete comfort by night.

The self-contained roomette combines luxury with economy travel. Complete privacy by day and night ... foam rubber beds, wide seats, individual washing and toilet facilities.



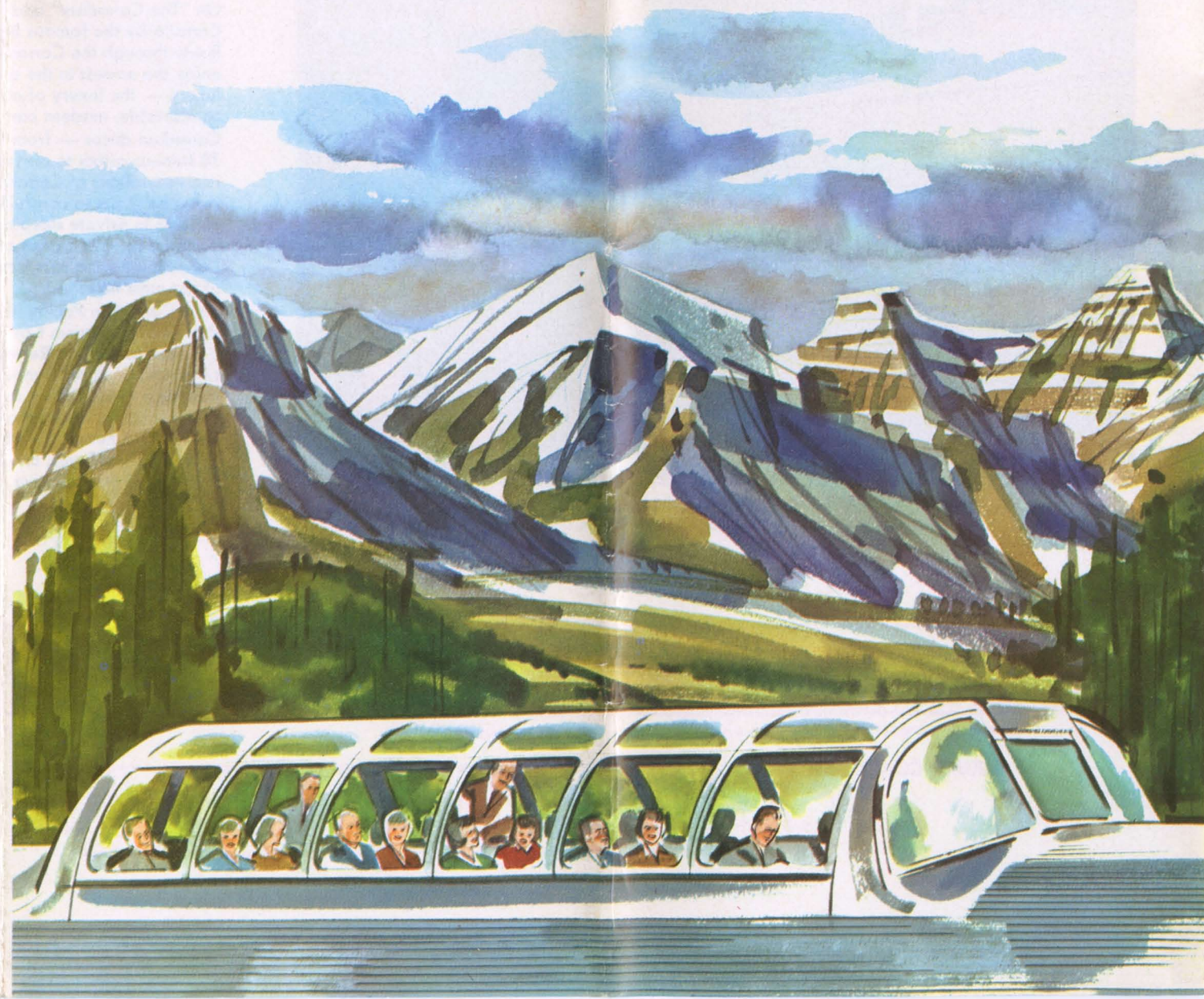

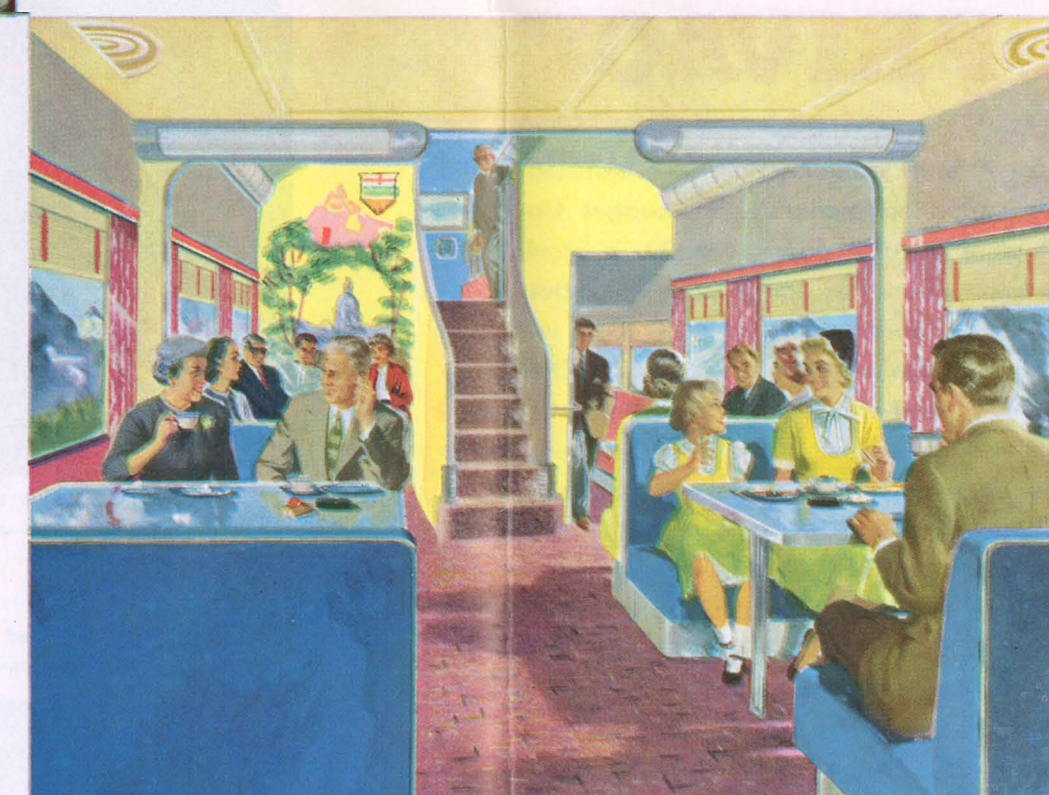
