## CHAMPLAIN'S HABITATION, NOVA SCOTIA.

The Canadian Pacific way to Nova Scotia takes you across the Bay of Fundy by smart, speedy "Princess Helene" to Digby, holiday resort and tide-water junction of the Dominion Atlantic Railway. From Digby it is a short ride to Annapolis Royal, site of historic Fort Anne and nearest railway station to Port Royal where Samuel de Champlain established "The Order of the Good Time" to while away long winter evenings.

Today the "Order of the Good Time" is open to all Nova Scotia's visitors. They may not spend pioneer winters on the shore of Minas Basin, but they can drive over Canada's first road (it has been kept in good repair) from Annapolis Royal to Port Royal where an authentic replica of Champlain's Habitation of more than three centuries ago has been reconstructed.

Stockade, barracks, Officers' Mess, store-rooms, well, chinked log buildings, stone chimneys, re-create the days when Champlain and his associates played their historic part in opening up great areas of the North American continent.
