DUNSTANBOROUGH CASTLE

Reached from Christon Bank Station. The grandeur of its site is its characteristic feature. During the Wars of the Roses it was taken and re-taken no less than five times, and reduced to ruins by artillery bombardment. The principal remains consist of the Keep, the Lilburne Tower constructed about 1325 and the Southern Wall which was defended by four towers.

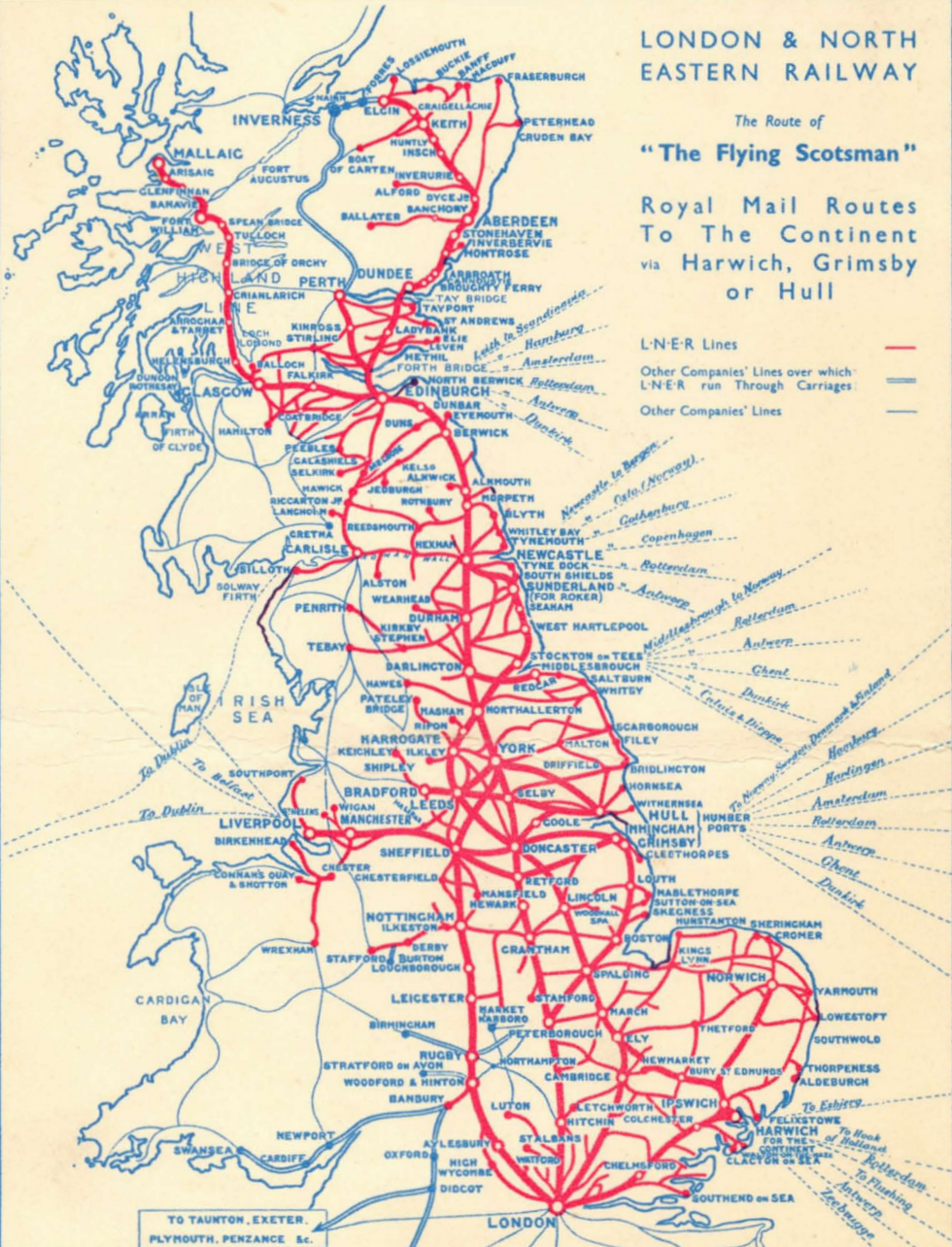
