As you visit the cars of this wonder train, you'll see evidence of the months spent in planning for the ultimate in beauty, convenience and comfort.


Each of the six Diesel-powered trains required for California Zephyrservice consists of a lounge-observation car with Vista-Dome; three all-room sleeping cars (one operating between New York and San Francisco); a distinctively-styled car with 16 semi-private sections; dining car; a buffet-lounge and three coaches, each with Vista-Dome. All cars are air-conditioned.

Windows throughout the Zephyr have sills at elbow height and are mist-proof, frost-proof and heat-resistant. Radio and recorded music provide choice programs. Telephone service between the diner and the lounge-observation enables passengers to make advance table reservations.

A public address system extends throughout the train. Through this system passengers may be paged and special announcements made.

A uniformed Zephyrette provides hostess service. Valet service may be obtained through sleeping car porters.

By far the most distinctive of many innovations on the California Zephyr are the spacious Vista-Domes,* built into the roofs of each of the three coaches, the lounge-observation and buffet-lounge cars.

In each of the five air-conditioned Vista-Domes, under heat and glare-resistant glass, are 24 deep-cushioned seats. Here, passengers, seated with heads well above the train's normal roofline, may ride in comfort and revel in an unobstructed view of some of the world's most breath-taking scenery. Towering peaks—color-splashed canyons—forest-fringed lakes—roaring rivers—verdant valleys—Mother Nature on parade!

The Vista-Domes afford marvelous opportunities for camera fans. The best results may be secured by using twice the normal amount of exposure time.

There is no extra charge and seats in the Vista-Domes are not reserved.

Rest and Relaxation in the Vista Dome

The spacious and luxurious lounge-observation car at the rear of the train and immediately behind the sleeping cars, furnishes congenial lounging facilities on three different levels for as many as fifty passengers.

Modern ingenious designing and expert fabrication combine to make a composite unit of four distinctly separate accommodations in this exquisite car.

The "main floor" lounge is located within the gracefully rounded end of the observation car. Here, deeply-cushioned occasional chairs and settees, in shades of sandalwood and brown in a setting of rose-tan and petal beige, invite complete relaxation.

Carpeted and individually-lighted steps from the lounge lead to the distinctive air-conditioned Vista-Dome—tastefully decorated in tones of sandalwood. Here, enclosed in shatter-proof, glare-resistant glass, are twenty-four deep-cushioned seats, where passengers may ride in comfort and enjoy a complete view in every direction.


Nestled beneath the Dome is a buffet. Tastefully decorated in rose and gray-green, it provides a delightful rendezvous in which to speed the miles and minutes. At one end of the buffet is a refreshment counter with carved linoleum base and back bar of stainless steel and etched mirrors. Electric refrigeration units assure an ample supply of cool, refreshing beverages at all times. The buffet has a telephone connection with the dining car, over which table reservations can be made.

Forward from the buffet are three bedrooms and a drawingroom, each having enclosed toilet facilities. Each room is attractively decorated in harmonious shades of rose-tan, petal beige, taupe and ashes of roses.

This car is completely carpeted and windows are equipped with Venetian blinds—those in the observation-lounge having drapes of gold and white.





Berths in the semi-private section car are revelations in comfort.

The California Zephyr has three allroom cars, each having six double bedrooms and ten roomettes and a distinctively-styled car with sixteen semi-private sections—two of which are 6 feet 8 inches long, "tailor-made" for the tall traveler.

Each room has toilet facilities (those in the bedrooms are enclosed), circulating, electrically-refrigerated drinking water, radio, individual temperature control and 110-volt outlets for electrical appliances. All rooms have double-width windows and the roomette beds can be lowered with door closed. Various en suite combinations of rooms can be arranged.

The color harmony in the all-room cars is a restful blending of rose-tan, petal beige and shades of gray in combination with ashes of roses and soft greens. In the section car, rose-tan, Norway blue, petal beige and green predominate. Venetian blinds and foam-type cushioning add to the charm and comfort of these cars.



The California Zephyr is distinguished for its wide variety of accommodations. Popular among these is the buffet-lounge car.

Beneath the Vista-Dome is the sip and snack lounge. Walls are in mauve-rose adorned with decorative murals in tones of greens, with light ecru Venetian blinds covering the doublewidth windows. Smartly patterned carpeting graces the floor.

An atmosphere of sociability is assured by a unique arrangement of built-in lounge seats. The radio provides soft background music, adding to the spirit of geniality.

In the forward end of this car, directly connected with the lounge, is the buffet with accommodations for nineteen. Decorated in grays and greens with complementary shades of vermilion and gold, it offers a cheerful rendezvous where friends may gather for a snack or to converse without fear of disturbing early retiring passengers. Sandwiches and coffee are served and electric refrigerator units assure an ample supply of cool, refreshing beverages at all times.

REFINEMENTS · CONVENIENCES · LUXURIES IN THESE


Comfort and convenience are outstandingly apparent in the three Vista-Dome coaches on the California Zephyr. There are forty-six seats on the "main floor" of each coach—all reserved and specifically assigned in advance. Chairs are adjustable to several reclining positions. All have cushions constructed of resilient rubber. Chair arms are generously upholstered and arm rests, dividing each seat, fold out of the way when not in use. Adjustable leg and foot rests add the final touch to complete comfort.


Soft pillows are available for night travelers and lights are


grav, henna and brown; the second in soft shades of turquoise, brown, beige and green; the third in Indian red, orchid-gray, woodtone and burgundy.

The Vista-Domes are similar to the one in the lounge-observation car—each accommodating twenty-four passengers. There is no reservation necessary nor extra charge made for these seats.










WESTBOUND—The Zephyr leaves Chicago in mid-afternoon, arrives Denver about breakfast-time next morning, glides through the mighty Rockies and reaches Salt Lake City that evening. Next morning it enters California through Beckwourth Pass, in the heart of the majestic Sierra Nevada, then follows the Feather River through the spectacular Feather River Canyon, one of the highlights of the trip. Oakland,

San Francisco and the Golden Gate are reached in the afternoon. EASTBOUND—The Zephyr leaves San Francisco in the morning, traverses the Feather River Canyon and the Sierra before dusk and arrives at Salt Lake City in the early morning. After a glorious trip through the Rockies, Denver is reached in the evening and Chicago soon after noon the following day.
