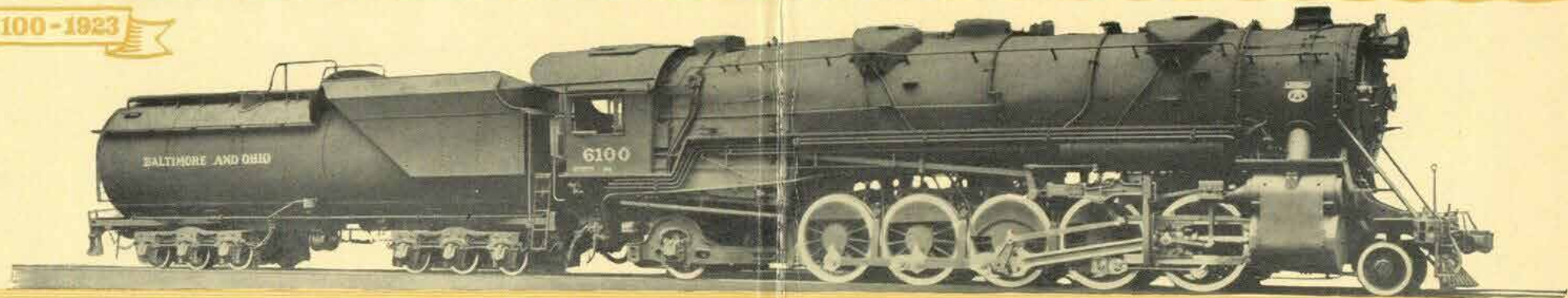

THIS Santa Fe type locomotive was first used on Baltimore and Ohio in 1923. It has power, a reasonable degree of speed and is used in both fast freight and slower movements. With its 64-inch

drivers, substantial weight of 734,900 pounds and tractive force of 84,300 pounds, it yields in sheer efficiency to no other type—which no doubt accounts for its popularity with American railroads.
