


ATTRACTIVE DINING CAR

The Dining Car on the NATIONAL LIMITED presents an inviting and colorful environment. It offers something new in Dining Car construction and appointments.

In the Dining Room there is a center ceiling lighting arrangement of the louvre type—indirect and glareless. The Cocktail Section is illuminated by a continuous center ceiling glareless lighting system. On each side of the car between the windows are three gold back panel mirrors. Silhouetted on each mirror is a figure representing some industry on the Baltimore & Ohio System—farmer, miner, steel worker, seaman, apple blossom girl and milk maid. The side walls are covered with bouclé drapes to harmonize with the color scheme.

THE Sun Room-Observation-Lounge cars are attractive in their appointments—different from the ordinary observation car.


A spacious glass-enclosed sun-room affords a splendid opportunity to view the interesting region traversed by the Baltimore & Ohio.

There is a writing desk, library and end tables with softly shaded lamps, comfortable chairs, settees and divans upholstered in colorful designs.


Beverages and light refreshments are served from the fully equipped soda fountain buffet.








WHEN ENTERING NEW YORK
