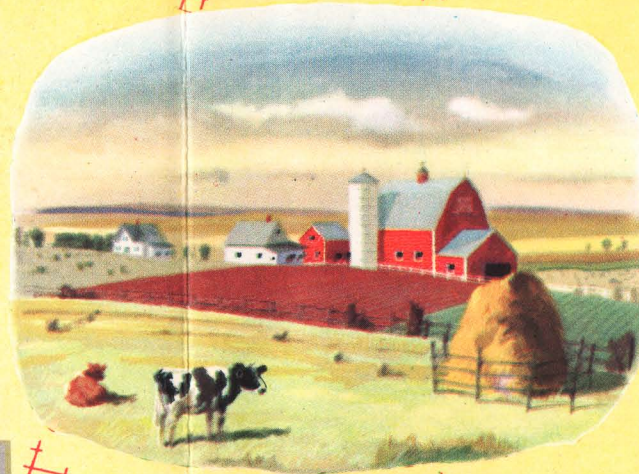

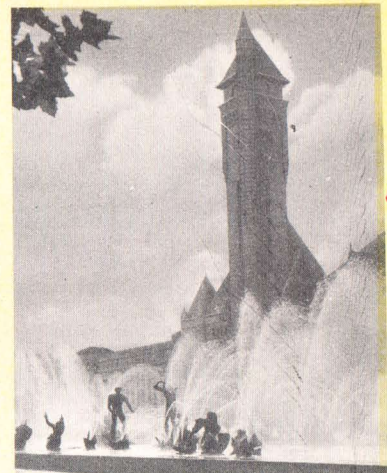
FAMOUS "BOYS TOWN" NEAR OMAHA, NEBRASKA
Omaha is noted as a rich market for livestock from the Western ranges.



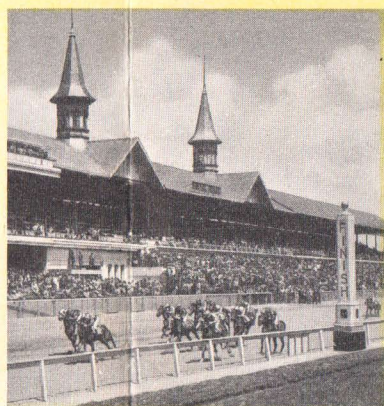
KANSAS CITY ON THE MISSOURI RIVER

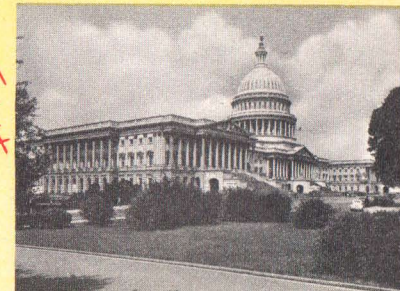
"WEDDING OF THE WATERS" AT ST. LOUIS

Scene of the Kentucky Derby, one of the East's great yearly racing classics.



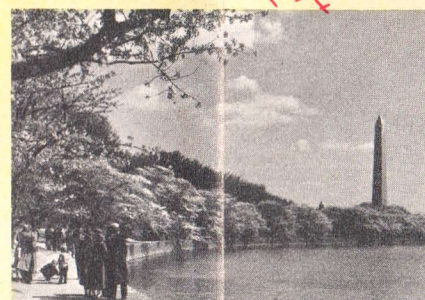

and climb to the top of the Washington Monument, built of stones from every state and territory.



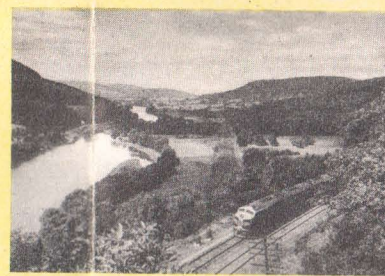
BIRTHPLACE OF THE "STAR SPANGLED BANNER"

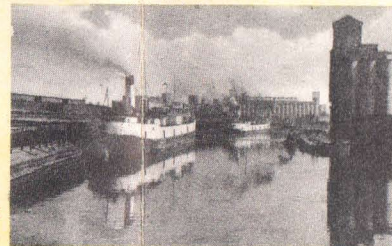

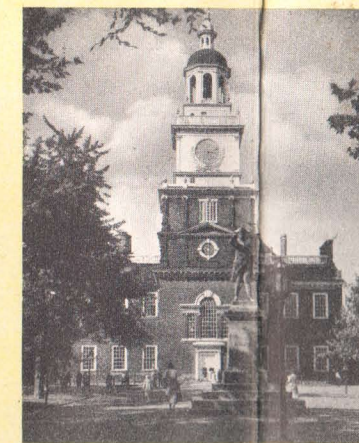

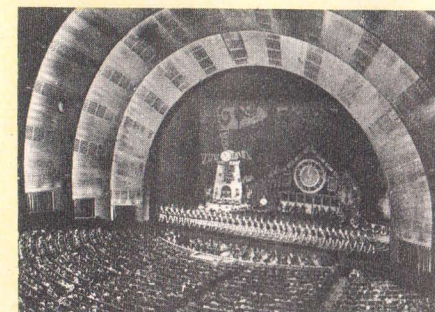

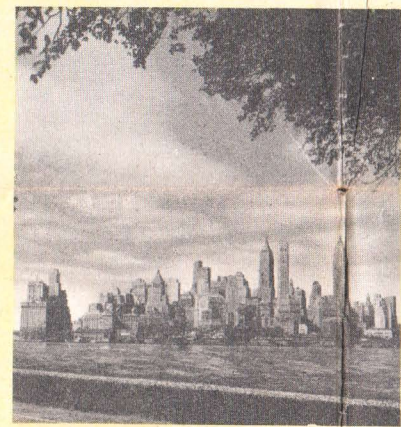

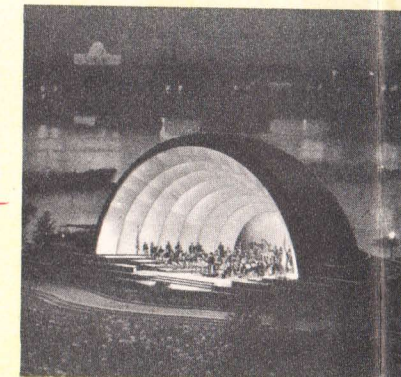
THE BIRTHPLACE OF AMERICAN INDEPENDENCE

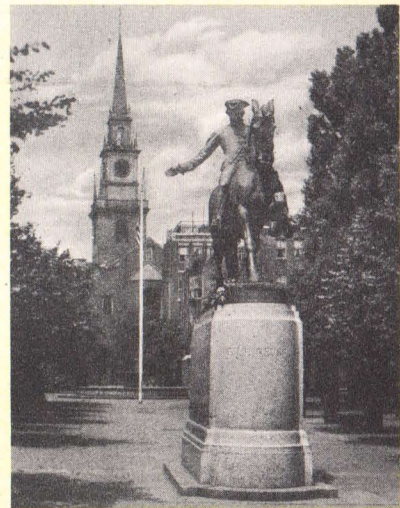

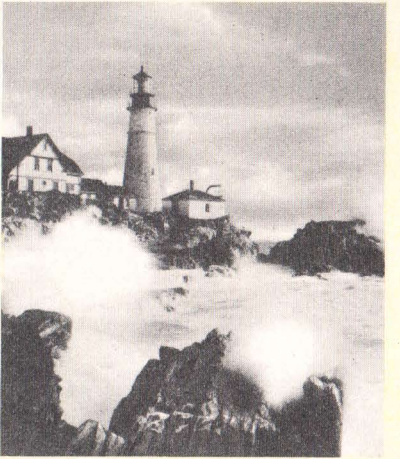
