The work of a modern railroad traffic department, like that of today's industrial sales department, goes far beyond selling! Our big job is to help people make the best use of our railroad, and to see that our operations are tailored, as far as it is economically and physically feasible, to best serve our customers. SUGGESTIONS FOR READING YOUR TIME TABLE

First find the station in which you are interested, in the index below and turn to the table or tables indicated. Note carefully any symbols in the schedule columns and their explanation in the Reference Notes on page 12. If ★ appears before the station name, train number indicates train which stops on signal at that station. If no regular or flag stop is shown, consult agent. When † appears before station name it indicates Freight Service only. Time from 12:01 midnight to 12:00 noon (A. M. time) is shown in light face figures; time from 12:01 noon to 12:00 midnight (P. M. time) is shown in heavy face figures. All time shown is Central Time unless otherwise indicated.

ALL TRAINS OPERATE DAILY EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE INDICATED.

In the time tables read the figures **DOWN** on the **LEFT** of the station names and **UP** on the **RIGHT**. The time shown opposite a station name is the time trains are scheduled to be at the station. Where no time is shown, trains do not stop.

The Condensed Schedules, Tables A to L inclusive, are of assistance in planning extended trips on the Illinois Central and connecting lines. The equipment of through trains is shown in connection with the condensed tables.

The four pages of geographically correct maps in the center of this folder will enable you to locate your station and route.

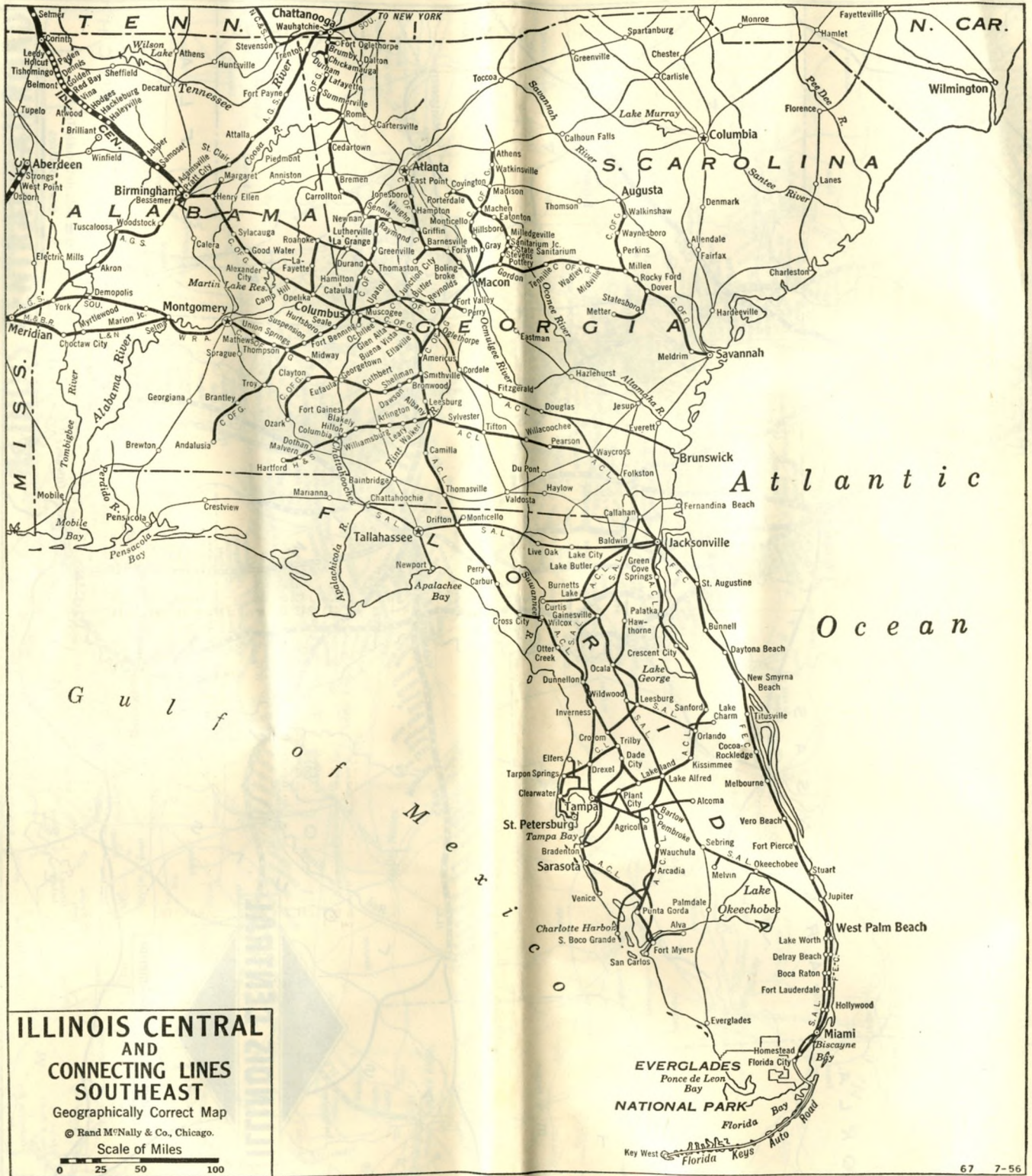
