The Company is not responsible for errors in timetables nor for inconveniences or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections. Although it rarely happens, schedules are subject to change without notice.



TIME from 12:01 midnight to 12:00 noon is shown in light-face figures and time from 12:01 noon to and including 12:00 midnight in bold face figures. Schedules are shown in Eastern Standard Time.

FEDERAL REVENUE ACT imposes a tax of 10% on the cost of transportation (when 36 cents or more) including cost of seats and berths.

LIMIT of one-way tickets between stations on the New Haven Railroad is one year. Limit of round trip tickets is shown thereon.

STOP-OVERS are allowed on one way and round trip tickets at any station enroute, within the final limit, upon application to the conductor.

STOPPING TRAINS ON SIGNAL. To board a train scheduled to stop only on signal, notify the ticket agent. Where there is no agent, display the signal provided for that purpose. To leave train, notify the conductor upon boarding train.

INVALIDS AND INFIRM PASSENGERS. Wheel chair service is available at principal stations and the company will gladly arrange to assist passengers requiring special attention to and from trains. There is no charge for this service. Advance notice may be given to the station master or to any passenger traffic representative of the company.

CHILDREN'S FARES. Children five years of age and under twelve years travel for half the adult fare while for children twelve years of age and over the fare is the same as for adults. Children under five years of age, when accompanied by parent or guardian travel without charge.



RESERVATIONS. Any ticket agent will assist in obtaining space for you in Parlor or Sleeping cars. It will help in planning your trip if reservations are made and tickets purchased as early as possible. Reservations made in name are limited as to length of time they will be held and tickets must be purchased before expiration of the time limit. Should your travel plans change, please cancel your reservations immediately so that the space will be available to others. One 1/2 transportation fare is required when seat or berth is occupied by one or more children under 5 years of age. Two 1/2 transportation fares will cover exclusive occupancy of section by two children of half-fare age.

When members of the same family or party occupy one or more drawing rooms, single or double bedrooms, roomettes, compartments, sections, or berths on the same train, additional transportation tickets will not be required if the total number of Sleeping Car transportation tickets presented for each member of the entire family or party is equivalent to the minimum requirement for the exclusive occupancy of the total space occupied by the entire family or party.

For minimum number of transportation tickets required for exclusive occupancy of compartments and drawing rooms in sleeping and parlor cars operated South of Washington and West of Chicago, passengers should consult Ticket Agent.

TRAVELERS AID. Representatives of Travelers' Aid Society are at many of the larger stations for the purpose of relieving distress and assisting the unprotected.

At Grand Central Terminal, New York and at South Station, Boston, nursery facilities are available to mothers and infants.

Enroute, train and dining car personnel will render every possible assistance to those travelling with children. And, for additional convenience, a special menu indicates a choice of meals for the children.

BAGGAGE: You are urged to check all baggage, except what is needed enroute and to be sure your baggage is clearly marked with name and permanent address. (Checkable baggage is defined as personal effects in use or necessary for the journey but does not include liquids, jewelry, money, negotiable papers, fragile articles, typewriters, radios or foodstuffs). The carrier assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to or caused by any excluded items. Subject to tariff regulations, 150 pounds will be transported on full fare ticket and 75 pounds on half fare ticket without charge, except a service charge of 25 cents will be assessed for each suitcase or other piece of hand baggage and 50 cents for each trunk at time of checking.

A single piece must not exceed 300 lbs. or 72 inches in greatest dimensions nor \$2,500.00 in value. Free allowance on adult ticket is 150 lbs. and maximum of \$100.00 declared valuation (in writing). Extra value may be declared at low rates.

Every effort is extended for prompt handling of baggage but no guarantee can be given as to handling on same train as owner nor arrival time at destination.

Delivery service may be arranged in principal cities direct to Steamship Piers and business, or private addresses on payment of delivery charges.

CHECK BAGGAGE A DAY IN ADVANCE. It is good practice to check baggage one day in advance of trip and we so recommend. Twenty-four (24) hours free storage time after arrival of baggage at destinations is allowed.

STORAGE. A charge is made for storage of baggage left at railroad stations longer than the free time limit.

RED CAP PORTER SERVICE. Red Cap Station Attendants, who are salaried employees, are available at principal stations to handle passenger's baggage at charge of 25 cents per piece of hand baggage.

Railroad liability for loss or damage is limited to \$50.00 per bag or parcel, but greater value at low rates can be declared in writing at baggage rooms in accord with tariff which is available for inspection at stations.

TRANSPORTING PETS. Dogs and small household pets (such as cats, birds, etc.) are not permitted in coaches (except in carrying cases and when not offensive to passengers), but may be checked for handling in baggage cars, subject to tariff and State regulations. Exceptions are made for Guide Dogs accompanying blind persons. Pullman Company regulations permits small animals (unless offensive to passengers) to be carried in basket or container when passenger occupies private room space. DOGS not in containers but on leash and muzzled may also be carried in private room space.

LOST ARTICLES. Loss of personal articles left in coaches or Pullman cars should be reported promptly to nearest ticket agent or passenger representative, with full description of article, train and date on which lost, and points between which you travelled. Every effort will be made to recover your property, but no liability can be assumed on unchecked articles. Inquiry may also be addressed to Manager, Baggage, Mail and Express Traffic, Boston, 10, Mass. Inquiry concerning articles left in Pullman cars should be made of Superintendent, Pullman Company at New York 17, or Boston 10, Mass.

REDEMPTION OF TICKETS. The redemption value of NYNH&HRR tickets will be refunded to the original purchaser upon presentation of tickets at any ticket office or at the Passenger Traffic Department, Boston 10, Massachusetts. Wholly unused tickets are redeemable at the tariff fare paid. The redemption value of partly used tickets is determined by allowing the difference between the amount paid and the value of the transportation actually provided on basis of the lowest applicable tariff fare for the service rendered. Most refunds are subject to a service charge of 15 cents which is deducted from the amount of the refund. Should it not be possible for ticket agent to make immediate refund agent will forward ticket to Passenger Traffic Department for adjustment.

Pullman tickets may be redeemed by Ticket Agent providing cancellation is made for sleeping car space the day before train is placed for occupancy and for parlor car space sufficiently in advance to permit space being released and replaced on sale, except that tickets for sleeping car accommodations in through cars operated to destinations in the State of Florida south of Jacksonville and Baldwin, will be redeemed if space is released on or before the third day preceding the day train is placed for occupancy. Otherwise tickets should be sent to General Passenger Agent, Pullman Company, Chicago 54, Ill.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES. In event of disagreement with conductor or agent, pay the fare required, take receipt and communicate with Passenger Traffic Department, Boston 10, Mass.

A TIME AND TROUBLE SAVER. Western Union telegrams may be sent from any telegraph station. Domestic Service; Full Rate Telegrams (fast service at reasonable rates). Day Letters (inexpensive deferred service), Night Letters (overnight service at reduced rates).

INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL. Permanent residents of the United States do not require passports to enter Canada. United States citizens must, however, present satisfactory documentary evidence of citizenship in order to enter Canada, or to return to the United States. A birth certificate or naturalization papers are the best forms of evidence.

A resident of the United States who is not a citizen must first obtain, from the nearest field office of the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service, a Resident Alien's Border Crossing Identification Card. If the non-citizen's visit is to extend for six months or longer he should first obtain a Re-entry Permit from the United States Immigration authorities.

If you are traveling between the United States and Canada, the Customs and Immigration Officers will want to interview you and examine your baggage when the train arrives at the border. Please have your baggage ready for inspection.

Air-conditioned equipment is assigned as far as possible, but the right is reserved to employ non-air-conditioned cars in emergencies or when the volume of traffic makes it necessary. When regular trains are operated in two sections the coach section may not have a meal car.

USE OF PARLOR CAR FACILITIES

Where Buffet Parlor cars are operated, the accommodations, facilities and services provided therein are available only to passengers holding tickets for space in such cars, or other Parlor Cars on the same train, and railroad tickets good for travel in Parlor Cars, or paying the Parlor seat fare and additional railroad fare for the distance travelled in such cars, when space is available therein. All Parlor Car service, both local and interline, is operated by the Pullman Company.

SLEEPING CAR ACCOMMODATIONS

The various types of sleeping car accommodations shown herein are usually available, however, it is sometimes necessary to make revisions in the style of cars operated on Saturday nights and during holiday periods.

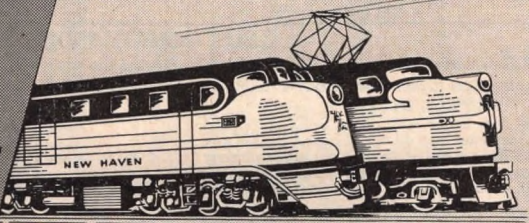
