

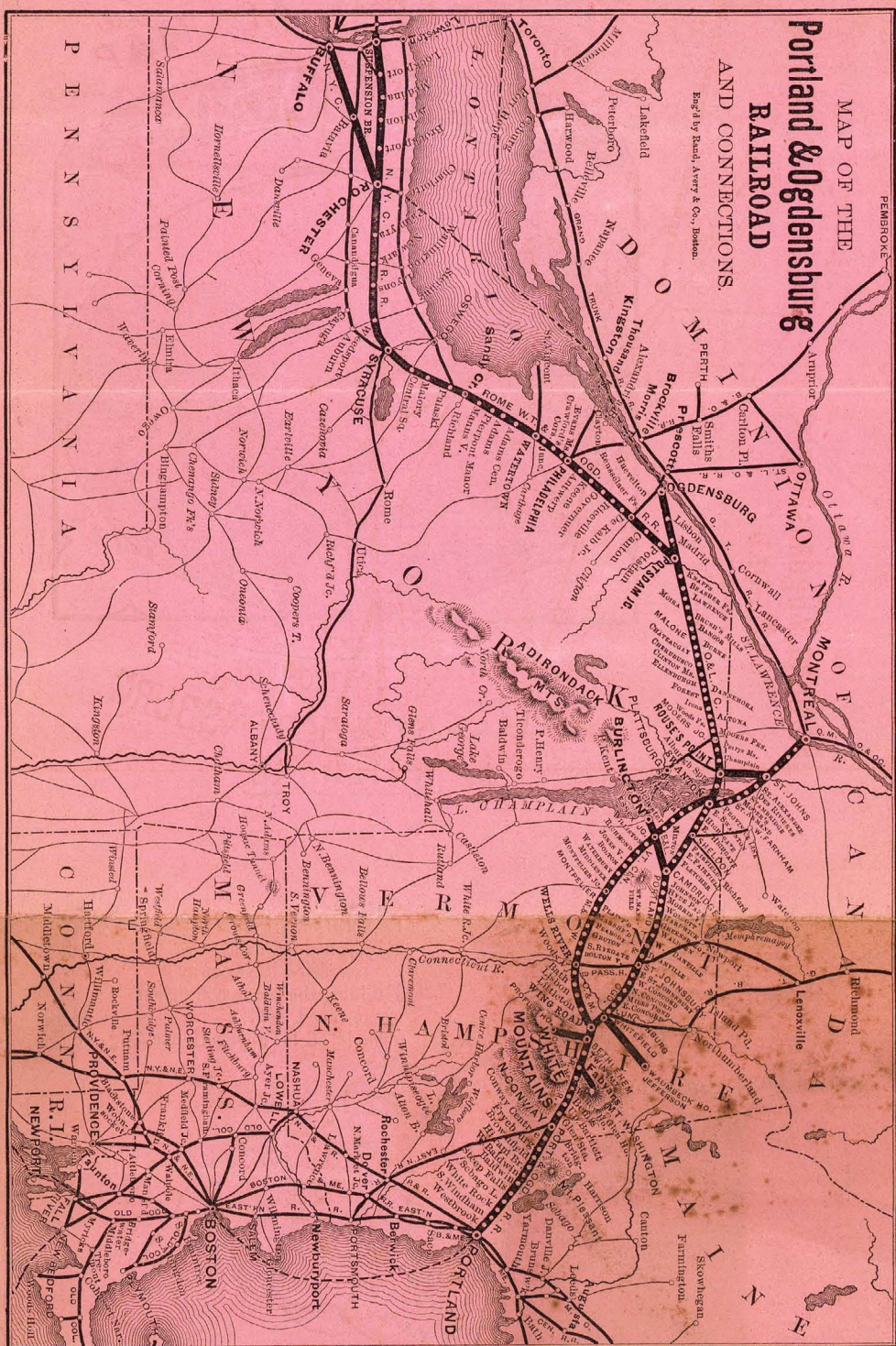

AMPLE facilities are offered by the arrangement of Trains for the Season of 1879, for the Excursion through the Notch, and enjoying the wonders of this famous trip at hours to suit the wishes and convenience of mountain visitors. The beauties and grandeur of mountain scenery may, as the taste or curiosity of the tourist dictates, be viewed by sunrise or sunset, at mid-day or in the dusk of evening, and the R.R. connections at Fabyan's with Profile House, Bethlehem, etc., brings it within easy access of visitors at those resorts who wish to experience this most interesting of all the mountain excursions. Round Trip Tickets between Fabyan's and No. Conway are sold at reduced rates, and parties who may not find it convenient to use the P. & O. BOSTON CONNECTIONS.

Steamers leave Boston daily at 7.00 P.M., arriving in Portland early next morning, connecting with 8.00 A.M. P. & O. R.R., and reaching Mountain points in advance of all other lines. Steamers of International S.S. Co. leave Boston Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays at 8.00 A.M., arriving in Portland at 5.00 P.M., in season to connect with 6.05 P.M. P. & O. R.R. through to Mountains and beyond. Pleasure-seekers will, by taking these lines, combine a delightful sea-trip with the charms of the Mountain excursion.

Boston & Maine trains leave Boston at 8.30 A.M. and 12.30 P.M., arriving in Portland 12.30 P.M. and 5.00 P.M., connecting with P. & O. trains, 12.45 P.M. and 6.05 P.M. First-class Restaurant at Transfer Station, and ample time for meals.

Eastern R.R. trains leave Boston at 8.30 A.M. and 12.30 P.M.; arrive Portland 12.30 and 5.00 P.M. Also leave Boston for No. Conway, 8.05 A.M., 12.30 P.M., arriving at No. Conway in season to connect for all points in the Mountains.

Steamers of P., B. & M. S.S. Co., "Lewiston" and "City of Richmond," make connection with 8.00 A.M. train P. & O. R.R. Steamer "Mt. Desert" connects via Rockland and Bath with 6.05 P.M. train. Steamers from St. John, Eastport and Calais connect with 8.00 A.M. P. & O. R.R.
