

Marias Pass, over the Continental Divide, affords the lowest Rocky Mountain railroad crossing in the Northwest.




For over 100 miles the Empire Builder follows the emerald green Kootenai River through the Canyon of the Kootenai, and passes Kootenai Falls.




In the area served by the Great Northern Railway, and not far distant from Glacier Park, are many of the country's finest Dude Ranches where real western living is available.

Grand Coulee Dam, one day round trip from Spokane, is the world's largest man-made structure and forms the longest artificial lake on any continent.





Grinnell Glacier, on "the Garden Wall," forms a majestic background for Lake Josephine in Glorious Glacier Park.






Minnesota can claim world-wide distinction as the "Land of Ten Thousand Lakes"—beautiful lakes that make you want to tarry awhile.




Minneapolis, world famous for its wheat milling, is also celebrated for its fine homes, parks covering one-tenth of its area, broad boulevards and nearby lakes.




St. Paul, headquarters city of the Great Northern Railway, is beautifully situated on the hills that border the Mississippi River at the head of navigation.




Rochester, beautiful town of about 20 thousand population in southeastern Minnesota, is the home of the famous Mayo Brothers Clinic.




Duluth, at the extreme western end of Lake Superior, is the head of Great Lakes navigation—an impressive city with one of the best natural harbors in the world.




From St. Paul the Empire Builder route follows the mighty Mississippi River—skirts beautiful Wisconsin—crosses northern Illinois to Chicago.




At Chicago's Union Depot, one of the finest in America, the Empire Builder makes convenient connections for eastern and southern points.



Chicago's boulevards and parks along nearly 25 miles of lake shore give America's No. 2 metropolis the world's most beautiful "front yard."




During the summer season, palatial steamships on the Great Lakes offer opportunities for long or short cruises on these "inland seas."




Detroit, famous motor city, is ideally situated on the world's busiest river. Here also is Henry Ford's renowned "Greenfield Village" and Edison Institute.

Cincinnati, extending about 14 miles along the Ohio River and upon hills on three sides, is a beautiful residential city and important commercial center.




Situated on the "Golden Triangle" formed by three great rivers, Pittsburgh occupies one of the most magnificent city sites in the world.




Of all sights on earth, few can compare with Niagara Falls. Nearly half a million tons of water catapult over the 158-foot precipice every minute.




New York is America's city of innumerable interests and continuous thrills—and the nation's chief manufacturing, business and financial center.




Rockefeller Center, including Radio City, is one of the miracles of this modern age and a "must see" on every New York visitor's list.




