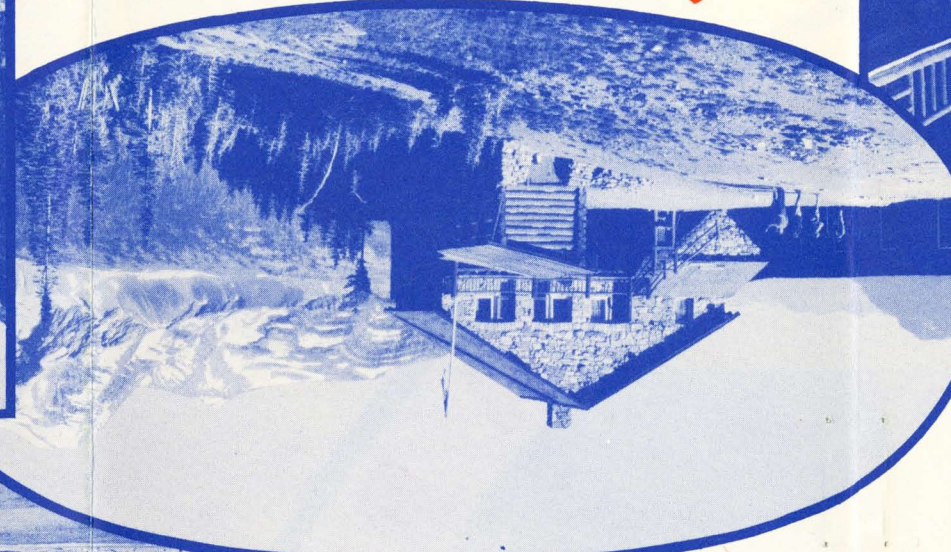




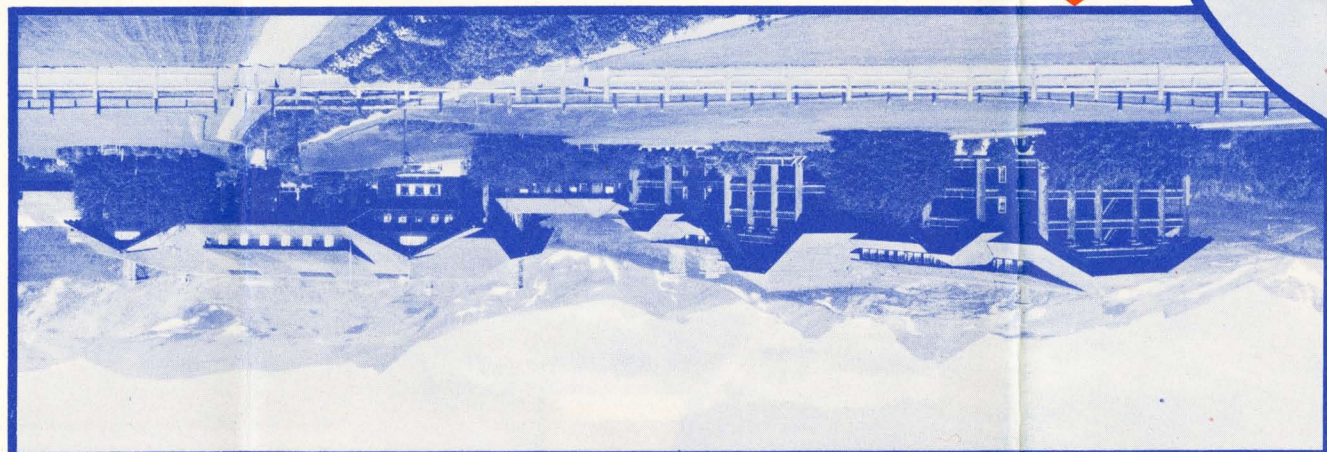

Glacier Park Chalet, on the east of the Continental Divide Range. It is the second of the chalets to be reached only by a park trail.

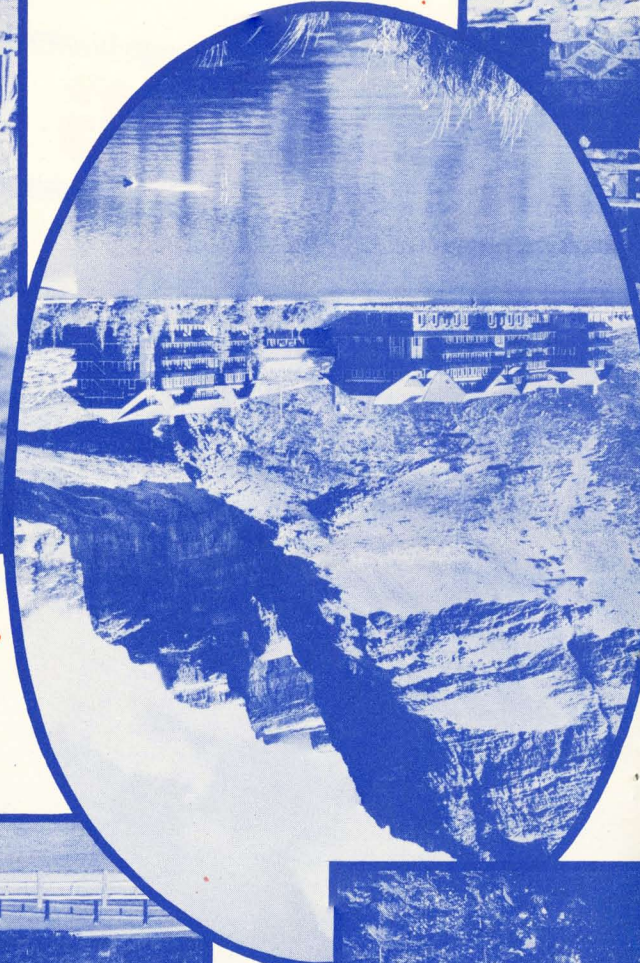
