
AN ALL-EXPENSE

## ITINERARY

Leave for your vacation any day - for example:

1st Day Leave Chicago Union Station 11:15 PM (CST) on the "Oriental Saturday Limited" famous Burlington - Great Northern train.

2nd Day Early this morning the picturesque Mississippi River approaching Sunday the Twin Cities - St. Paul-Minneapolis. Leave St. Paul, Minn. 8:50 AM. Sightseeing from the car window - Lake Park region of Minnesota and huge diversified farms of North Dakota.

Awaken in the glorious morning sunshine of Montana's ranging Monday prairies and oil fields for your first glimpse of the mighty Rocky Mountains. Soon Glacier National Park, then through and over the Rockies via Marias Pass.

Arrive Glacier Park Station 12:25 PM, Belton 2:10 PM, Columbia Falls 2:38 PM (direct connection for Kalispell arriving 3:08 PM.) The "Boss Wrangler" will meet you at your selected destination - Glacier Park Station, Belton or Kalispell depending on Dude Ranch of your choice.

4th to 13th Day, Tuesday to 2nd Thursday -- (10 full days at Dude Ranch) Up early each morning and into the saddle for there are adventurous days ahead. Even if you haven't been on a horse before it's a fine experience - and lots of fun. Ride through the forests and scenic mountain trails on a sure footed horse which you selected for your own, the day of arrival at the ranch -- perhaps a swim before dinner then an evening of restful leisure, gabfest and entertainment around a huge fireplace which lends its magic to the end of a perfect day.

Just think - ten days of your own free will. You may select to ride or hike wooded mountain trails, swim in crystal clear lakes, go fishin', go hunting camera wise or 'just loaf'. Pack trips and moonlight rides, yours to enjoy.

13th Day Thursday Reluctantly you pack your bags and say "Au Revoir" to dude ranch associates in taking leave from a grand vacation.

Leave Kalispell 3:25 PM for direct connection with the "Oriental Limited" leaving Columbia Falls 4:00 PM; Belton, Mont.

4:25 PM and Glacier Park Station 6:17 PM.

l4 Day Friday Relax to the music of singing rails as the train speeds homeward through ranging prairies and fields of golden grain on the air-conditioned "Oriental Limited" arriving Minneapolis 10:00 PM, St. Paul 10:30 PM.

15th Day Saturday Arrive Chicago Union Station 8:20 AM (CST) on the Oriental Limited via the Burlington Route.
