

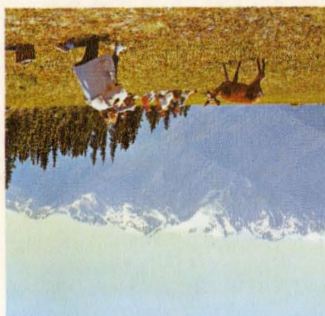

50-mile oceanscape of needle rocks, islands and primeval sea life borders Olympic Park to the west. Common sights: Seals on off-shore rocks; deer and elk from nearby mountains; Indians from four reservations.

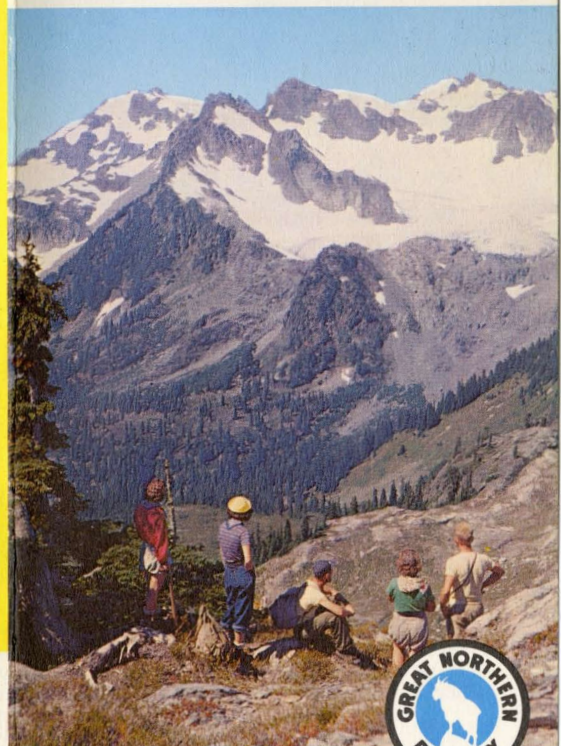
