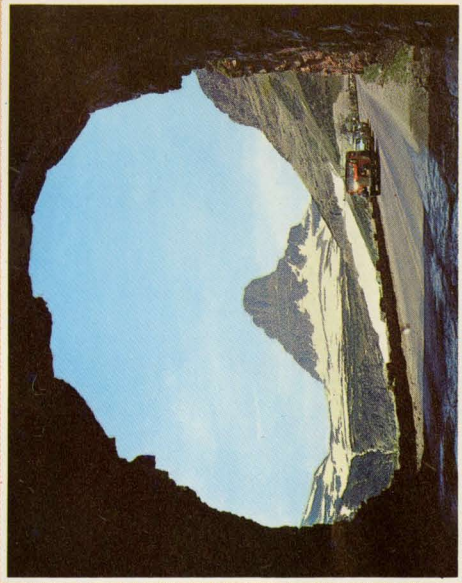
# Glacier!

Glacier is an unspoiled scenic paradise amid the "American Alps" in Northwestern Montana (and adjoined by Canada's Waterton Lakes National Park.)

Glacier boasts 60 live glaciers, 250 trout lakes, 1,100 miles of trails and thousands of wild flowers. Many species of birds may be seen; and the mountain goat, bear, and deer are observed in their natural surroundings.

Going-to-the-Sun Road, a trip you will never forget — beautiful lakes, magnificent mountains with snow-capped peaks. You can stand at the Continental Divide (the water from this point flows in three directions, the Pacific, the Atlantic and the Gulf of Mexico) and view beautiful McDonald Valley in a setting of virgin forests, mountain uplands, glacial lakes and snow-capped mountains.

Accommodations at Glacier to fit anyone's desires—beautiful large hotels, motel units or rustic comfortable cabins. At every stop in Glacier, accommodations are available.

- BY PLANE** . . . West Coast Airlines into Cut Bank, Montana and Kalispell, Montana. Northwest Orient Airlines and Western Airlines connecting to West Coast at Great Falls, Montana.
- BY TRAIN** . . . Great Northern's streamlined "Western Star" between Chicago and Seattle stops daily at West Glacier and East Glacier Park.

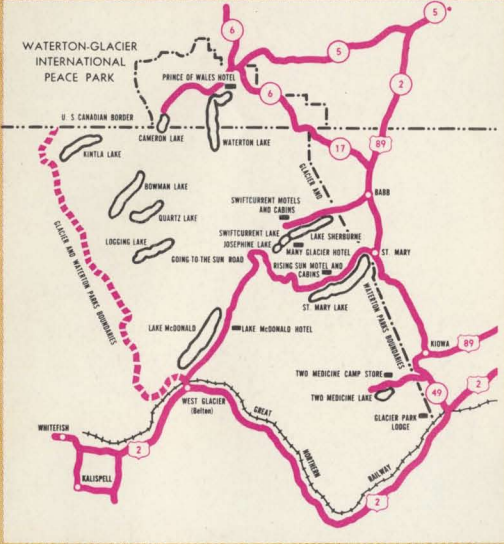

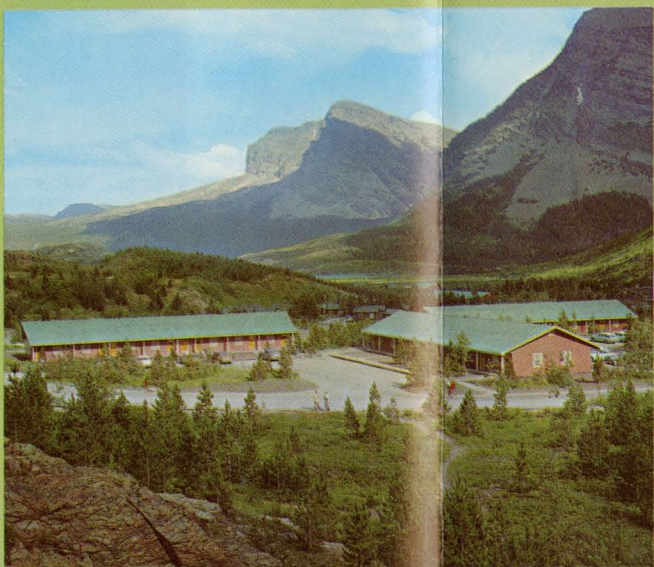
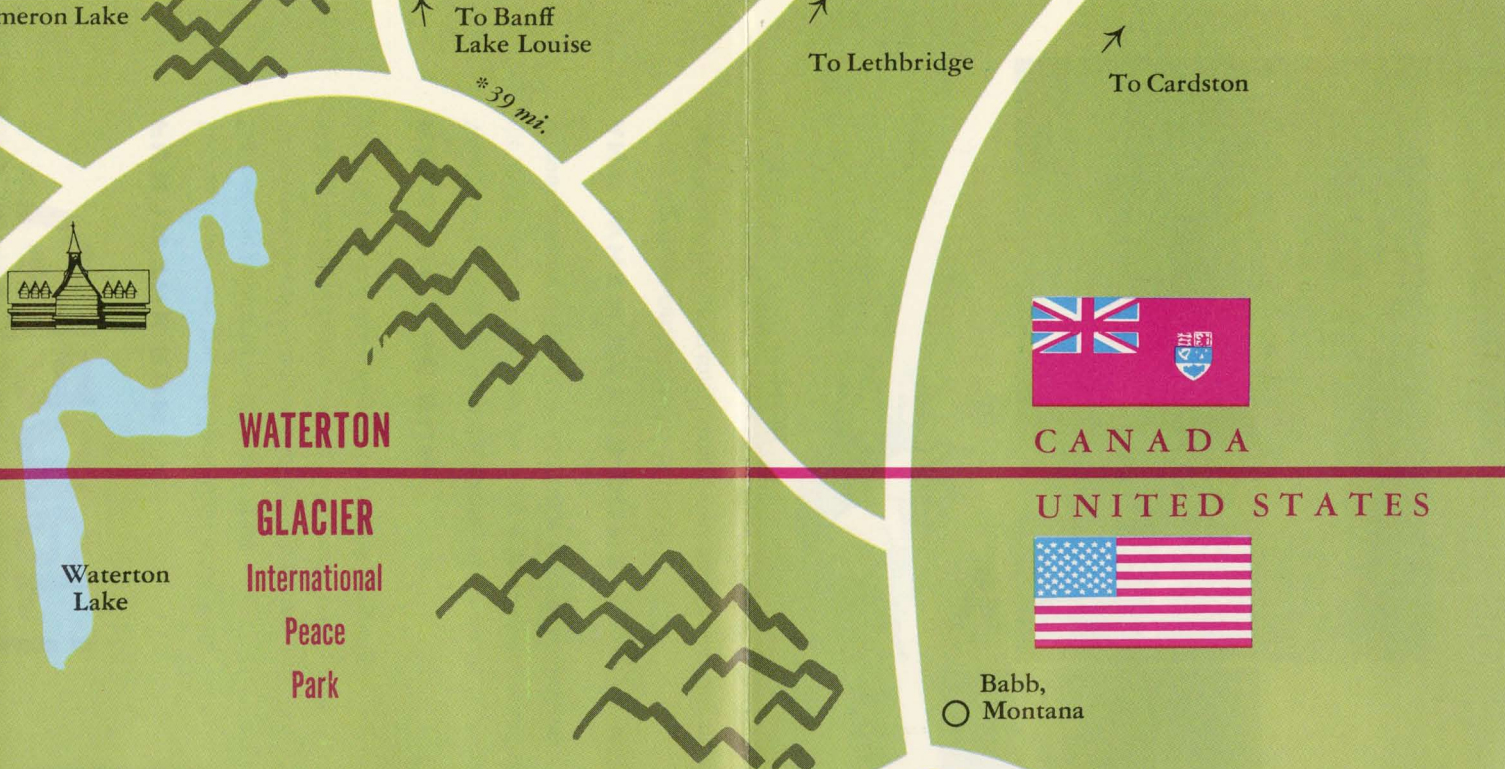
TRICK FALLS, in the Two Medicine Lake area, is a remarkable waterfall.



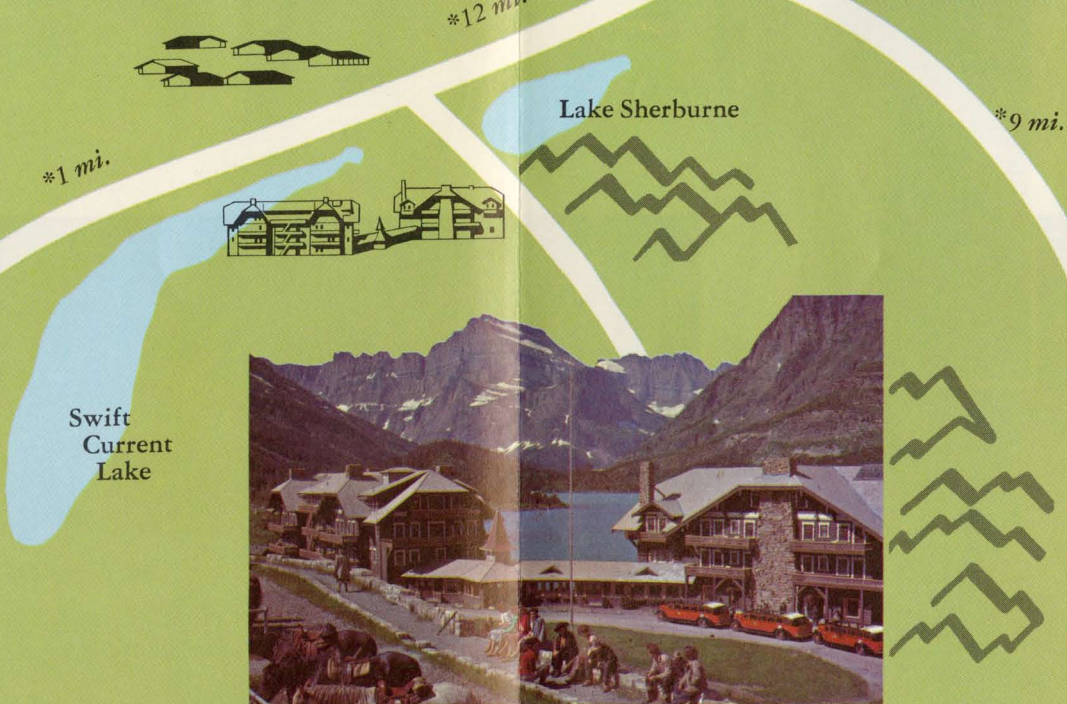




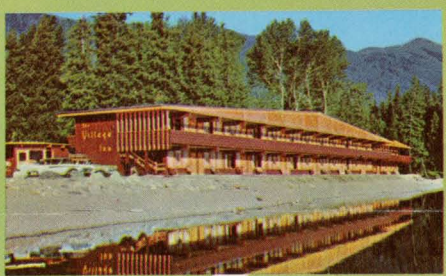

MANY GLACIER HOTEL, the showplace of the Rockies, overlooks Swiftcurrent Lake and is the center of activity.



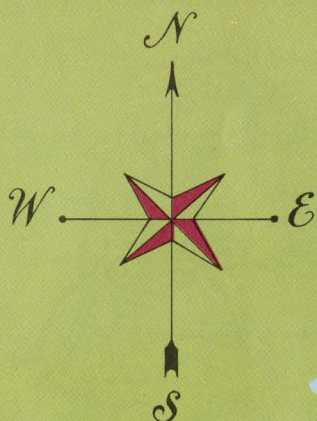
VILLAGE INN in Apgar, Montana, is a modern motel at the foot of beautiful Lake McDonald.



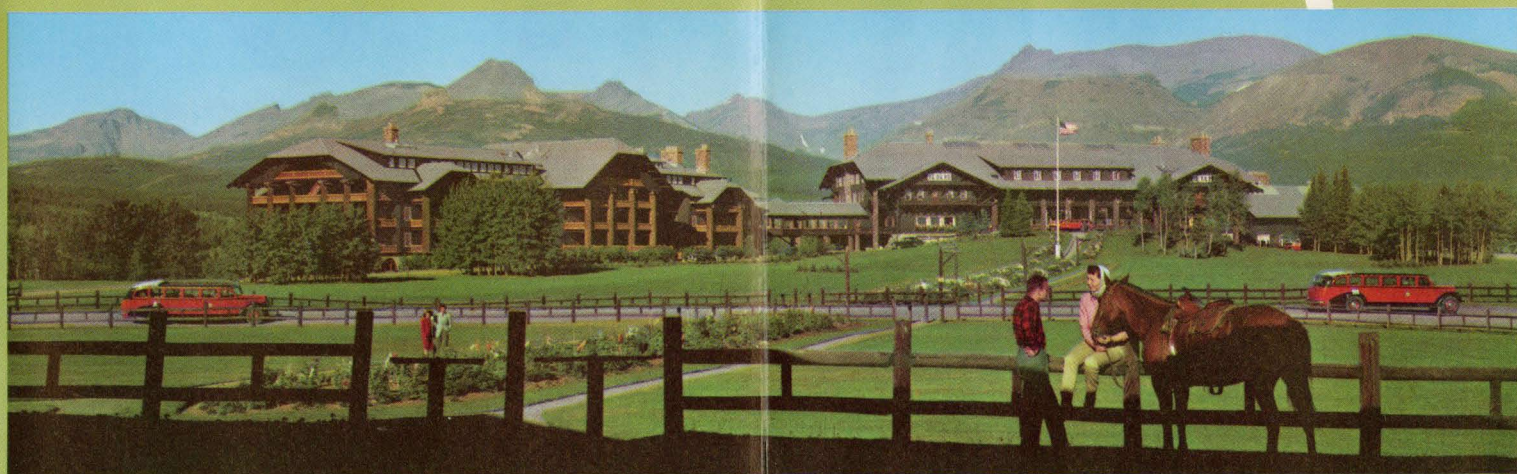
LAKE McDONALD LODGE, noted for its quiet charm, nestles under giant cedars on the shore of Glacier's largest lake.
