# TIMBERLINE LODGE

(MT. HOOD)



*"Mile high, million dollar Castle in the Clouds"*

Timberline Lodge is situated at an elevation of 6000 feet on majestic Mount Hood, which towers above to a height of 11,245 feet. Mount Hood may be seen many times along the scenic water level route of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway.

The Lodge was completed in September, 1937, by the Works Progress Administration. From the foundation to the roof, woods and stone native to the area were used. Furnishings, decorations, wood carvings—all were created by hand with Oregon materials by Oregon artists.

Architects of the United States Forest Service and Treasury Department created the first distinctly American mountain architecture in designing Timberline Lodge. "Cascadian" is the name given this powerful and massive treatment.

Timberline Lodge has one of the longest ski seasons in the United States—from November to as late as July. It is an easy sixty-three mile drive from Portland. As many as 2000 to 4000 visitors a day have come to ski or just thrill to the spectacular "top of the world" view of the Cascade Range.
