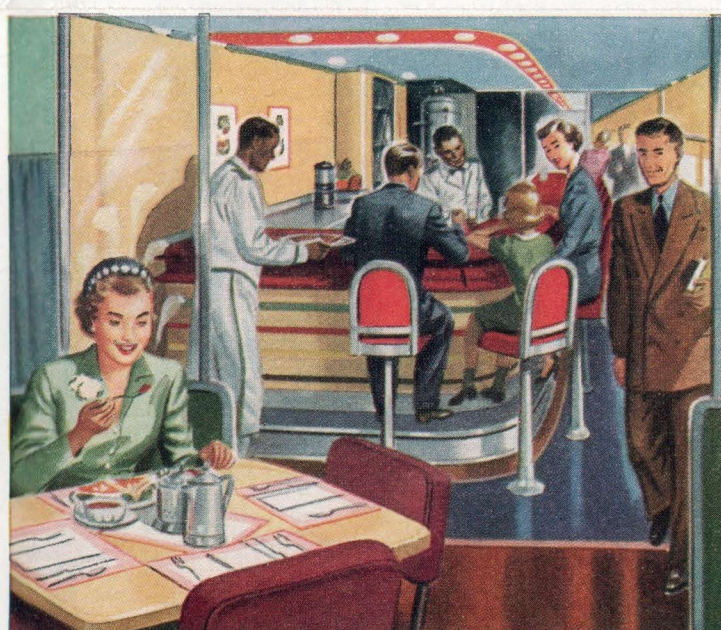
The Western Star serves Glacier National Park in the Montana Rockies daily June 15 through September 10.
