

## THE PULLMAN ROOMETTE

# What it offers and How to use it





## What the Pullman Roomette offers

THE "ROOMETTE" is a small completely enclosed, private room containing one bed, affording ideal accommodation for one person. There is a wide, roomy sofa in the daytime, offering ample lounging space and at night a bed which folds into the wall at one end of the room. The folding bed allows the passenger to make the whole room space and its complete toilet facilities available at any time. It is easy to raise or lower the bed, and balanced springs eliminate any difficulty during the operation. When the bed is made down for the night, it is fastened at the foot by a lock. This is easily released when the passenger desires to raise the bed. The length of the bed, 6 feet 5 inches, will appeal to persons over average height.

The door of the "Roomette" can be locked at night, or left open and a curtain drawn across the opening. The patron has individual regulation of ventilation, heat and light; complete toilet facilities, with washstand folding into one wall, and above it a mirrored cabinet for toilet articles, with tubular lights on each side; a locker in which to hang clothes and a niche for your golf bag; a large rack for luggage; a vacuum water bottle in cabinet, and a box from which the porter can remove shoes without disturbing the sleeper. Ceiling and reading lights of new design provide ample illumination. One daytime novelty is movable footrest, available if desired.

As the "Roomette" is completely air-conditioned the passenger can enjoy his pipe, cigar or cigarette, knowing that the smoke will be withdrawn almost immediately through a grilled outlet, and without discomfort to those in adjacent "Roomettes."

The ticket agent, conductor or Pullman porter will gladly explain all the advantages of the "Roomette" accommodation. The following typical rates show the cost of the "Roomette:"

### How to use the Roomette

OUR ROOMETTE offers many facilities designed for your travel comfort. By familiarizing yourself with the creature-comforts included in the Roomette, you will amplify the full enjoyment of your journey.




In the daytime your bed folds into the wall at one end of the room, as shown in figure 1, and you have a


sofa-seat of the latest and most comfortable contour, with ample space in the room for

lounging or undressing before the bed is lowered for the night.

To lower the bed all you need to do is to turn handle located above seat back (figure 2), pulling it down, and holding it in that position. Your bed will then lower on balanced springs, as shown in figure 3, easily and with little effort. Lower the bed until








it rests on its supports, then raise clamp from the bed clothes (figure 4) and fasten it in lock on wall, as shown in figure 5. Then your bed is ready for sleeping.

This lock (figure 5) is easily released when you desire to raise the bed and return it to its niche in the wall. Simply release the clamp and turn it down flat on the bed clothes, the bed then raises easily. Hold the



handle down until the bed has entered its niche to the point where it is engaged by the lock, then release handle.

There is a mirrored cabinet for toilet articles, as shown in figure 6. In this cabinet you will find a vacuum water bottle with fresh, cool drinking water and glass, and an ample supply of towels. In this cabinet you will find ample room for your toilet necessities. On each side of the mirror, there is a tubular light, and above the cabinet there is a rack for luggage.





The clothes locker (figure 7) is directly to the right of the cabinet and washstand. Dresses, a suit, or your golf bag can be stored here, out of the way.

Below the cabinet is your washstand which folds into the wall, as shown in figure 8. The washstand has a hot and cold water faucet Fig.7 and a dental faucet. To drain the

water, simply return the washstand to its place in the wall. Its facilities are available at all times.

In one corner of your ROOM-ETTE is an additional seat. By raising the cushion top of the seat,

> (figure 9) toilet facilities are afforded.



There are other conveniences provided in your ROOMETTE, such as: electric fan; outlet for electric razor, operating on 32 volts, or a transformer for 110 volts, available on call, and ash trays convenient for day or night use.

The porter in the car is at your call and will gladly explain the operation of any of these facilities, and assist you in obtaining the maximum comfort from your ROOMETTE accommodation.
