In July 1951, a fleet of 179 General Motors Diesel locomotive units on the Milwaukee Road—143 freight and 36 passenger—handled approximately 52% of the Milwaukee's gross ton-miles and 44% of its total passenger car miles. Ninety-one GM freight units acquired since 1948 helped increase gross ton-miles per train hour from 34,645 in that year to 44,245 in July 1951—a 28% improvement in efficiency!
