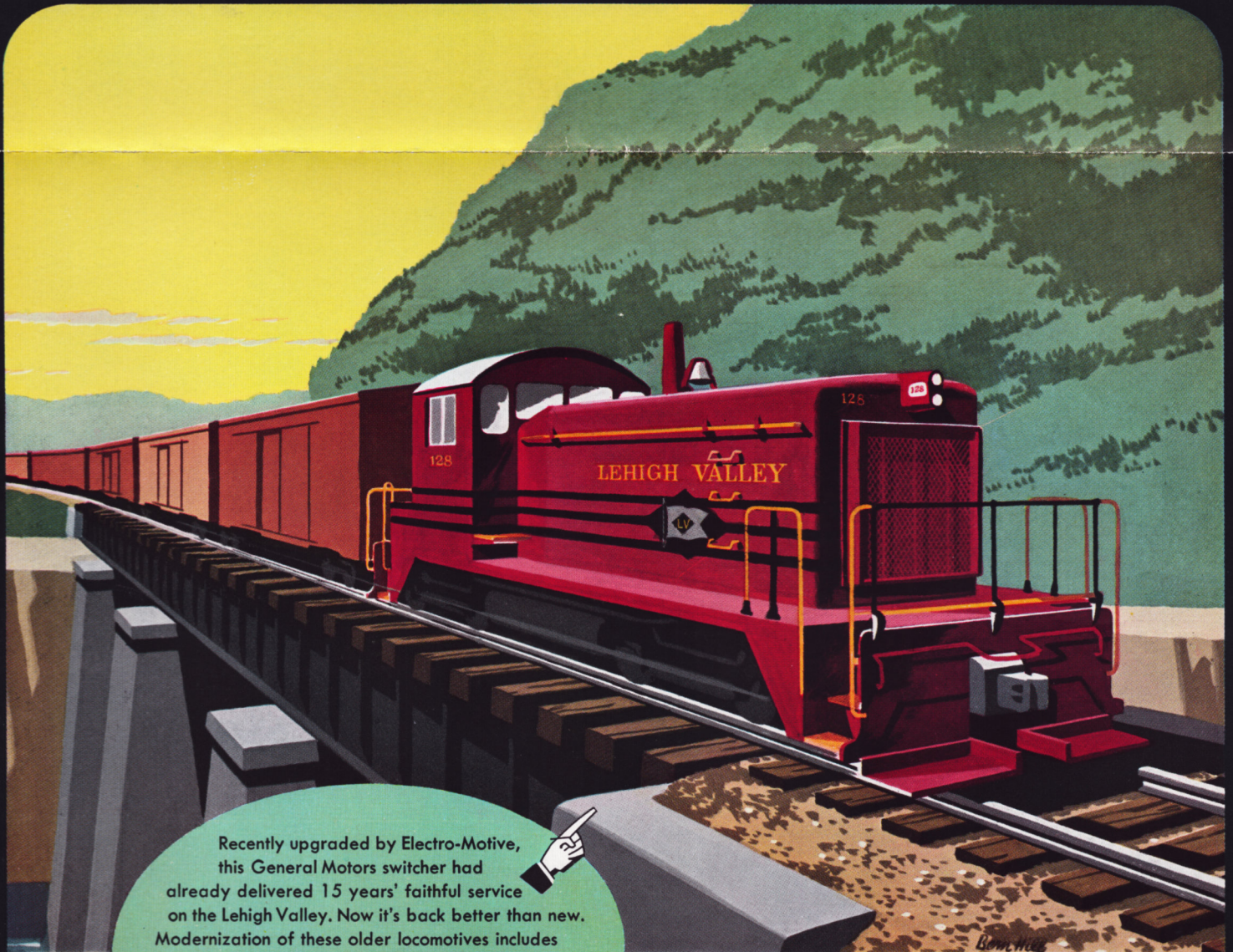

Recently upgraded by Electro-Motive, this General Motors switcher had already delivered 15 years' faithful service on the Lehigh Valley. Now it's back better than new. Modernization of these older locomotives includes remanufacture of electrical rotating equipment, new controls and replacement of the original 12-201A engine with a modern 8-567C Diesel. In the modified SW9, eight cylinders do the work of twelve—and that means lower cost.
