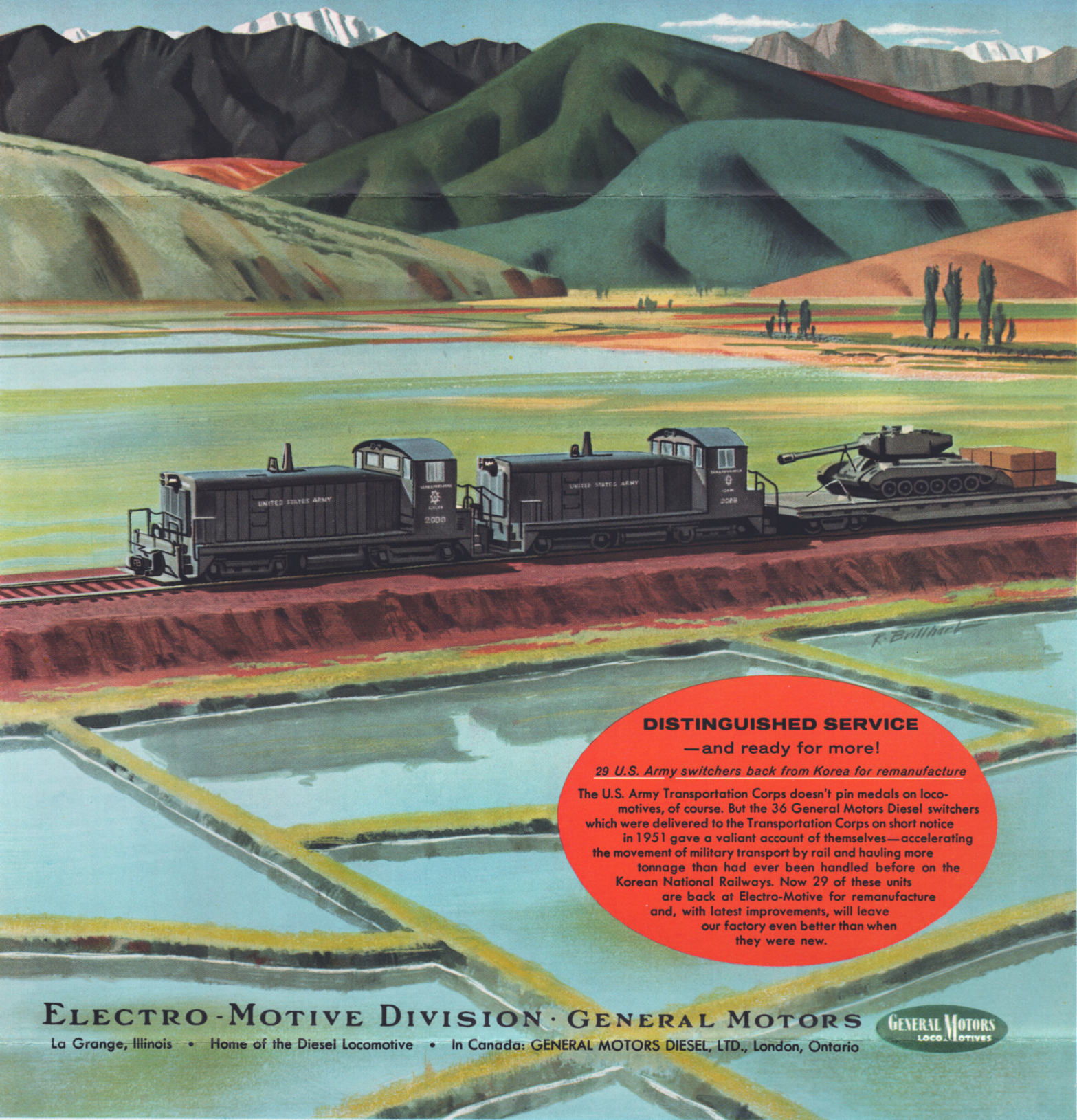

29 U.S. Army switchers back from Korea for remanufacture

The U.S. Army Transportation Corps doesn't pin medals on locomotives, of course. But the 36 General Motors Diesel switchers which were delivered to the Transportation Corps on short notice in 1951 gave a valiant account of themselves—accelerating the movement of military transport by rail and hauling more tonnage than had ever been handled before on the Korean National Railways. Now 29 of these units are back at Electro-Motive for remanufacture and, with latest improvements, will leave our factory even better than when they were new.
