

## **Suggestions for Reading a Time Table**

First, locate station in index which is alphabetically arranged. The numbers opposite the station refer to the tables in which service to or from that station is shown. On the left-hand side of table read the time from top to bottom, on the right-hand side, from bottom to top. Where no time is shown, trains do not stop. All reference marks for which explanation is usually given on same page should be read carefully. Time shown in light numerals indicates a.m. **Time shown in dark numerals indicates p.m.** Unless otherwise indicated, the time at each station is the leaving time.

Unless otherwise indicated, the time at each station is the leaving time. In all Milwaukee Road schedules **Central Standard Time** is used east of Mobridge and North Platte, Neb.; **Mountain Standard Time** west of Mobridge and North Platte, Neb.; **Pacific Standard Time** west of Ogden, Utah. Schedules and fares herein are subject to change without notice.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Liability.** This railroad will not be responsible for errors in time tables or fares, inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failures to make connections.

### Buy Tickets before boarding trains.

**Children under five years of age, when accompanied by parent or guardian, will be transported free of charge. Children five years of age and under twelve years of age will be charged one-half of the ticket fare for adults. Children of five and under twelve years of age who are not mature enough to take care of themselves when traveling alone can not be ticketed unless accompanied by parent or guardian. Children of twelve years of age and over will be charged the adult fare.**

**Adjustment of Fares.** In cases of misunderstanding with Conductors or Agents, pay the fare required, take receipt and communicate with Mr. J. K. Pain, General Passenger Agent, Room 702, Union Station, Chicago 6, Illinois.

**Redemption of Tickets.** Applications for redemption of unused portions of tickets issued by the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad should be addressed to Mr. J. K. Pain, General Passenger Agent, Room 702, Union Station, Chicago 6, Ill. The unused portions of tickets issued by other railroads should be sent to passenger traffic manager of issuing railroad.

**Through Tickets** to points on other lines are sold at principal stations (see index reference +) and baggage is checked thereon to destination. Persons desiring to purchase through tickets at stations where they are not regularly on sale can procure same by giving ticket agents sufficient time to secure them.

**Tickets Must Be Used Within Limit.** One-way tickets will be honored within thirty days and round-trip tickets within six months from date purchased. Passengers must reach destination not later than midnight of date of expiration.

**Baggage.** Certain trains of this Company do not carry baggage. To facilitate prompt receipt of baggage at destination, passengers are requested to check it in advance in order that it may be forwarded on a preceding train. Baggage is not always forwarded on same train with passenger.

**Baggage Maximums and Restrictions.** No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight, or \$2,500 in value, will be checked. 150 pounds of ordinary baggage, as defined in baggage tariff, not exceeding \$100.00 in value will be checked free on each adult ticket, and 75 pounds not exceeding \$50.00 in value, on each half fare ticket. EXCEPT that when in boxes constructed of wood, or heavy corrugated pasteboard, the free value allowance will not exceed \$25.00 per passenger for any one or more of such containers. Boxes of heavy corrugated pasteboard will be limited to gross weight of 50 pounds. Tickets purchased on the Family Plan are limited to 300 lbs.

**Baggage Service Charge.** A service charge will be collected for each piece of hand baggage and each trunk checked for forwarding. Hand baggage 25 cents each, Trunks 50 cents each.

**Baggage Liability.** Value must be declared and if value in excess of the free allowance (\$100 for 150 lbs.—\$50 for 75 lbs.) is desired it may be declared at a charge of 25c per hundred dollars and paid for at time of checking.

**Bicycles** (not motorcycles), Baby Carriages, Dogs and Guns are transported in baggage cars subject to tariff regulations.

Dogs and other household pets when carried in baskets or containers, may be taken only into ROOM accommodations in sleeping or parlor cars subject to Pullman regulations. (Exception: Dogs may be on a leash if they are muzzled). Such animals when crated, may also be checked for movement in baggage cars upon payment of tariff charges. (Exception: Dogs may be checked on a leash if they are muzzled). Special arrangements apply for Seeing Eye Dogs.

**Lost Articles.** Don't forget your parcels—any loss should be reported immediately to General Baggage Department, 221 Union Station, Chicago 6, Illinois, or nearest agent or representative—the Railroad will not be responsible for uncheckered articles.

At Chicago, all Milwaukee Road trains arrive at and depart from the Union Station, Adams & Canal Sts.

Passengers arriving at Chicago holding tickets reading to points beyond with a "Railroad Transfer Service" coupon are transferred by that company to outgoing station without charge. Transfer of hand luggage is included in this arrangement.

**Baggage Transfer at Chicago.** Passengers whose tickets do NOT include a "Railroad Transfer Service" coupon should consult uniformed agents of that company who will arrange for transfer of baggage to hotels, residences and other stations at a nominal charge. Taxi-cabs are also available.

**Telegraph Service.** Western Union Telegraph Co. accepts telegrams, cablegrams, night letters, etc. at all telegraph offices.
