**T**HE Old West, so full of romance, heroic action, Indians, Scouts, Cowboys, bronchos, big-horn steers is re-created every summer in the rodeos, round-ups and frontier-day celebrations of the cow country.

Whoop-ee! Nothing like it for thrills in the world—genuinely American, typically western—the Rodeo—brilliant horsemanship, Indian races, tribal dances, bucking cayuses, wild-steer riding, round-up contests.

**Mr. Ticket Agent:** Tell your customers to include a round-up or two, when traveling West this summer. Here are the dates to mark in red on your calendar:

## August 3-4-5—Bozeman, Montana, Round-Up.

"She's Wild." Dick Ringling of Ringling's Circus in charge. "Greatest Show on Earth No. 2." Bozeman Round-Up is only a few years old but, with the Ringling genius and backing, it has already become a bright meteor among the western round-up stars,—well worth crossing the continent to see.

*Bozeman is on the main-line of the Northern Pacific. Three trans-continental trains daily westbound and three eastbound.*

## July 1-2-3-4—Northern Idaho Stampede.

Where Idaho, Montana, Washington and Canadian cowpunchers compete. A great Wild West Show and Carnival, with bucking horse contests, wild horse riding, steer and fancy roping, bulldogging and steer riding in competition! The old range life of the West is reproduced on the Alan Race Track between Spokane, Washington, and Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. 25 big events daily, with a thrill in every event!

*The Stampede is reached from Spokane, which is a Northern Pacific city with three trans-continental trains serving it each day, westbound and eastbound.*

## July 19-20-21—Cheyenne Frontier Day.

This is Wyoming's annual Round-Up. Great riding, bucking and rope work. A time-honored event. Go to Yellowstone Park on the Northern Pacific first—in Gardiner, out Cody, Wyoming, then to Cheyenne on the Burlington and return home through Colorado.

## September 10-11-12—Ellensburg Rodeo.

The Washington Cowboys' celebration. Western contest, races, entertainment. Let'er Buck! Ellensburg is on the main line of the Northern Pacific with many trains daily serving it.

## September 16-19—Pendleton Round-Up.

Oregon's great show which attracts people from many states. The rivalries of the western ranches and plains are fought out here at the rodeo season's close.

*Pendleton is on the Pasco-Pendleton branch of the Northern Pacific and can be included as a part of a Pacific Northwest trip. Service from Spokane, Portland, Seattle, Tacoma and Pasco.*
