


The Vista-Dome North Coast Limited along Clark Fork River in western Montana







That was Northern Pacific's car program for 1960: 1800 new cars in all—just over \$20 million worth. Eight hundred 40-ft. box cars and 250 "RBL" refrigerators built in NP's Brainerd, Minn., shops. New freight cars include plug-door box cars (some are shown being hauled to the Pacific Northwest to transport lumber products), mechanical refrigerators, 85-ft. flat cars and 65-ft. gondolas. Our 1961 construction program continues to emphasize specialized equipment to meet shippers' needs.
