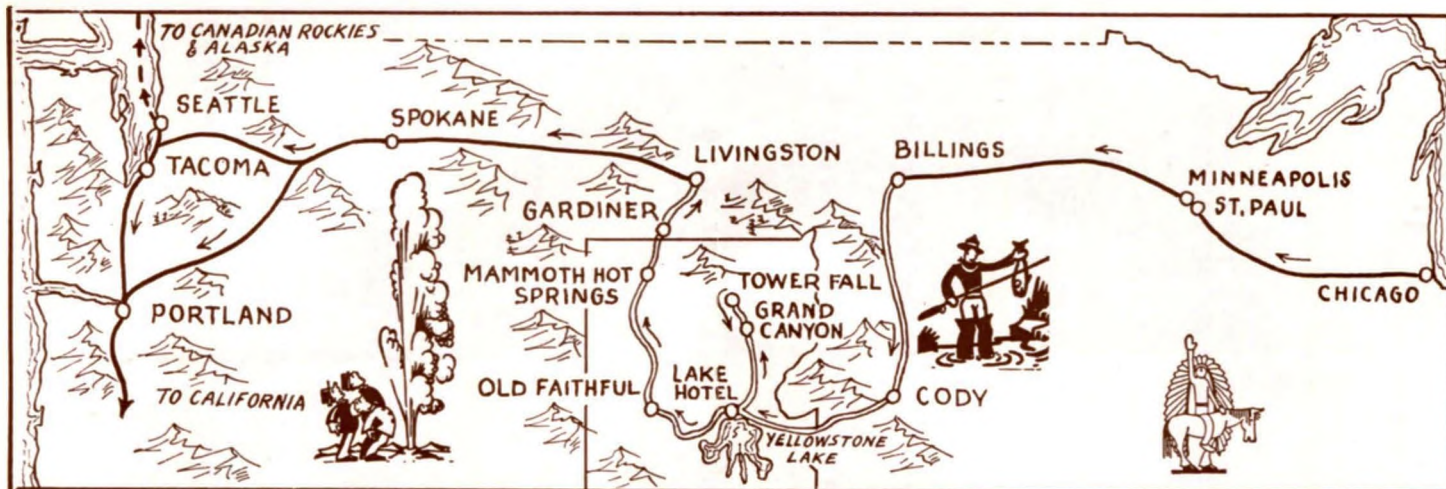

WESTBOUND— TOUR STARTS WITH DEPARTURE FROM CHICAGO

Day Program

1. Leave Chicago 12:10 pm, aboard the Vista-Dome NORTH COAST LIMITED, traveling along the scenic upper Mississippi River for 300 miles. Leave St. Paul 7:20 pm; leave Minneapolis 7:55 pm. Steak dinner provided in the dining car.
2. Along the Yellowstone River and ranch country. Breakfast in the dining car. Arrive Billings 10:48 am. Leave Billings promptly, via sightseeing bus to Cody, Wyoming, for lunch. Leave Cody after lunch, via beautiful Shoshone Canyon, Buffalo Bill Dam and over Sylvan Pass along the shores of beautiful Yellowstone Lake. Arrive Lake Hotel for dinner and lodging.
3. After breakfast, there's a thrilling side trip to magnificent Grand Canyon, where stops are made to

- view this beautiful masterpiece of nature. Here is the "Yellow Stone" of the Indians from which the park takes its name. Tour returns along the shores of beautiful Yellowstone Lake, Thumb, Continental Divide, to Old Faithful Inn for lunch, dinner and lodging.
4. After breakfast, tour continues past Firehole Canyon, Artist's Paint Pot, Norris and Gibbon Geyser Basins, arriving Mammoth for lunch. In the afternoon there will be a side trip by bus to Tower Falls and the canyon palisades, returning to Mammoth for dinner and overnight. The evening is open to explore the various hot springs terraces around the lodge. Entertainment available.
5. Breakfast at Mammoth. After breakfast tour continues via Eagle Nest rock, Gardiner Gateway, Yellowstone River, Yankee Jim Canyon and Paradise Valley. Tour ends on arrival Livingston, Montana. Lunch on your own after boarding westbound North Coast Limited at 1:07 pm, for a smooth ride thru the Rockies. Farewell chicken dinner included this evening. Trip continues westbound to destination arriving Portland 7:00 am; Seattle 8:30 am, the following day.



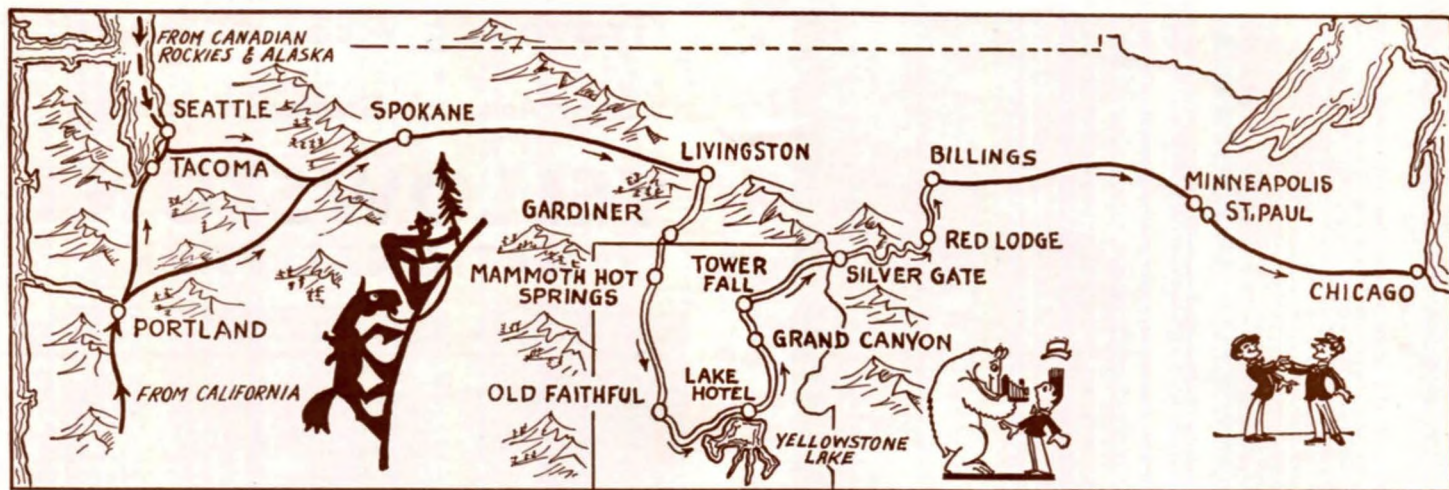

EASTBOUND—TOUR STARTS ON DEPARTURE SEATTLE OR PORTLAND

Day Program

1. Leave Seattle 1:30 pm, aboard the Vista-Dome NORTH COAST LIMITED for a thrilling daylight ride over the magnificent Cascade Mountains—or leave Portland 3:00 pm, traveling along the banks of the scenic Columbia River. Steak dinner provided in dining car.
2. Breakfast in the dining car, while viewing Butte, Montana,—greatest mining camp on earth. The train passes over the Continental Divide—scenic grandeur on all sides. Arrive Livingston 10:56 am. Luncheon on your own. Time to explore curio shops in this typical western town. Board your sightseeing motor coach at Northern Pacific Depot 1:00 pm, for drive along Yellowstone River through Paradise Valley, entering Yellowstone Park at Gardiner Gateway and proceeding to Mammoth for dinner and overnight. Entertainment available.
3. Breakfast and lunch at Mammoth. Visit the museum and many hot springs terraces. Leave Mammoth after lunch, via Hoo Doos, Golden Gate, Norris Geyser Basin and Fountain Paint Pots to Old Faithful. Dinner and lodging at The Inn. Plenty of opportunity in the early evening to see Old Faithful Geyser in all its glory, and to visit the shops in the area.
4. Breakfast and lunch at Old Faithful Inn. Ample time for “Ranger walks” to view some of the other

- great geysers here, or browse through the Old Faithful curio and picture shops. Leave Old Faithful after lunch, via Continental Divide, Thumb, and along the shores of beautiful Yellowstone Lake. Arrive Lake Hotel for dinner and lodging. Entertainment in the huge hotel lounge.
5. After breakfast, leave Lake Hotel for tour of Grand Canyon. Tour continues to Tower Falls, thence to Mammoth for lunch. In the afternoon tour continues over the magnificent Red Lodge High Road. View the many thrilling miles above 10,000 feet, safely riding in Northern Pacific sightseeing buses, amid lofty mountains of Wyoming and Montana. Arrive Red Lodge for dinner. To Billings and the Northern Hotel for overnight.
6. Breakfast provided at Northern Hotel. Morning free to see this interesting, modern western city. Lunch on your own. Board your streamlined North Coast Limited 1:13 pm, for scenic trip eastbound. Farewell chicken dinner provided in dining car.
7. Arrive Minneapolis 6:10 am; St. Paul 6:40 am, and Chicago 1:45 pm.

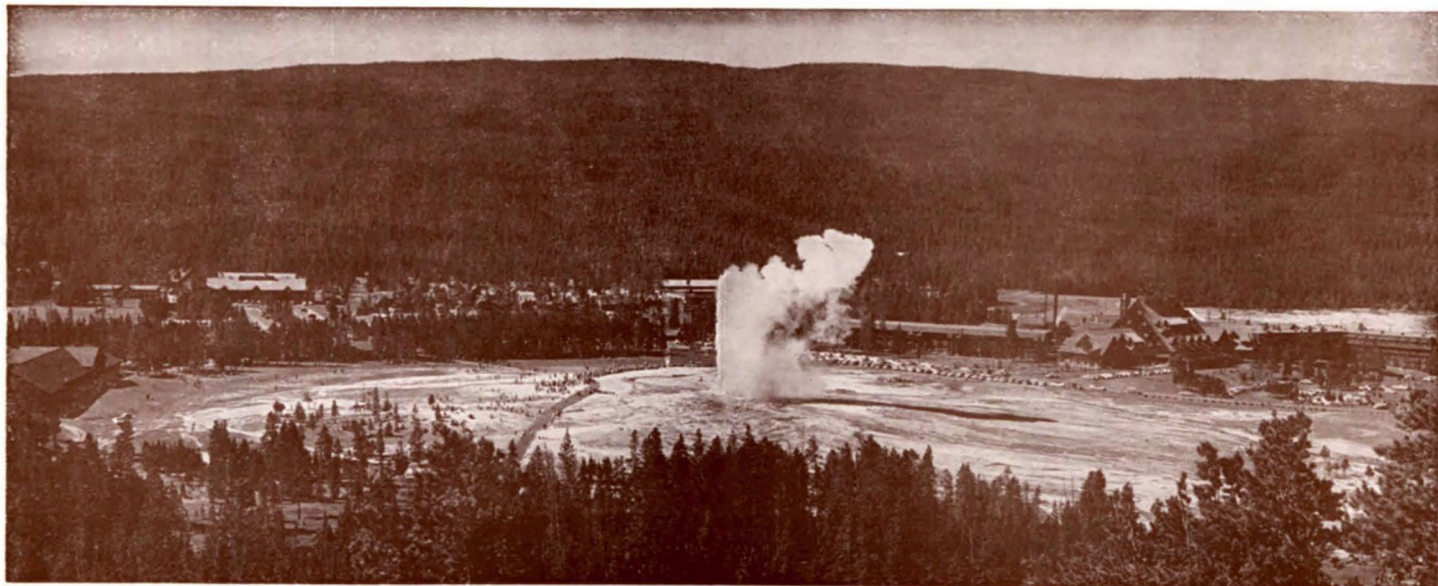
