Sales of Alcoholic Beverages are legal except, as follows:

ILLINOIS

Liquor, wine, and beer except on election days while polls are open, not until noon on Sundays.

WISCONSIN

No sales on election days during the time polls are open.

MINNESOTA

No sales on the following days between hours listed:
Sunday—1:00 A.M. and 8:00 A.M. Monday, except 3.2 Beer
can be sold from 12:00 Noon to 1:00 A.M. Monday.
Memorial Day—1:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M.
Election Days—1:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M.

NORTH DAKOTA

No sales on any election day, Sunday, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Christmas Eve after 8:00 P.M. and Christmas Day.

MONTANA

No sales permitted on Sunday until after 1:00 P.M., or on any day of an election during hours when polls are open.

IDAHO

No sales will be made during the (approximate 3 hours) this train is in the State of Idaho. Westbound trains enter Idaho 5 miles west of Heron, Montana, and leave Idaho about 2½ miles west of Hauser, Idaho. Eastbound trains enter Idaho 1½ miles east of Newman Lake Spur, Washington, and leave Idaho after departure Cabinet Dam.

WASHINGTON

No sales from 12:01 A.M. Sunday until 6:00 A.M. Monday. No sales on election days until after polls have been closed.

OREGON
