


## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Agents:** Each passenger should be provided with round-trip rail and park sidetrip ticket, via route selected, and Ticket Form G.L. 21, which covers complete package tour in Yellowstone-Teton area. Northern Pacific offices will provide you with Forms G.L. 21, and will make all train and park reservations in advance for every guest.

# YELLOWSTONE -GRAND TETON

## *National Parks*

THERE ARE MANY escorted tours to Yellowstone National Park, operated by responsible tour companies, and we heartily recommend them. Your railroad or travel agent will be glad to arrange escorted trips for you, either in Pullman cars or in modern coaches, and on a great variety of summer dates.

However, many travelers prefer to go on their own, and for them, the independent package trips described in this folder are attractive. Advantages: (1) You know costs before you start so you can plan accurately as to complete expenses on your vacation; (2) You are provided with reserved space on the North Coast Limited—the fastest service to Yellowstone Park; (3) You have tickets in advance, with coupons covering all services, except personal tips and meals aboard train, where tastes and appetites vary widely. (Meals average about \$7.20 a day on N.P. trains, and we suggest some allowance per vacation day for personal tips); (4) on these package trips your hotel, sightseeing and other reservations are made in advance; (5) you know right where you'll be each day, with arrangements carefully made ahead of your arrivals; (6) you may leave home any day in Summer and take advantage of these trips.

■ Rates quoted include bus transportation, meals and lodging within both parks. Rail and Pullman transportation to and from park gateways are additional.

## ITINERARY

**1st Day of Vacation**—Lv. St. Paul 8:25 pm; Minneapolis 9:00 pm, via Northern Pacific Railway. Reserved space provided on the Vista-Dome North Coast Limited.

**2nd Day of Vacation**—Ar. Livingston, Mont., 1:32 pm. Lv. Livingston promptly in sightseeing buses direct from train side, through Paradise Valley and up the magnificent Yellowstone River Canyon, between 10,000-ft. peaks of the Rockies. You'll see Antelope Meadows, Eagle Nest Rock, Boiling River, Mammoth Hot Springs formations and colorful terraces. Ar. Mammoth Motor Inn at about 2:50 pm. Remain at Mammoth Inn for dinner and lodging. Entertainment in Recreation Hall every night except Sunday.


**3rd Day of Vacation**—Morning at comfortable Mammoth Inn. We recommend the Mammoth Museum (best in Park, and just across the square from the Inn) and a morning walk to Opal Terrace (2 blocks), Liberty Cap, and to the hot springs terraces. Attractive gift shops to visit. Breakfast and lunch at the Inn. Lv. Mammoth 1:15 pm, through Silver Gate, Golden Gate Canyon, Norris, Midway, Lower and Upper Geyser Basins to Old Faithful. Ar. Old Faithful Inn 5:05 pm. Dinner and lodging at this famous hotel. Entertainment at Recreation Hall in the evening.

**4th Day of Vacation**—Breakfast at Old Faithful Inn and then away by bus at 8:30 am to Grand Teton National Park. Enroute you cross the Continental Divide twice, view Upper Geyser Basin containing more and bigger geysers than will be found anywhere else in the world, ride along beautiful Yellowstone Lake, West Thumb and on to Lewis Lake and the spectacular Lewis River. Grand Teton Peak, towering 13,776 feet above sea level, emphasizes the beauty of the entire Teton Range. Lying at the foot of the mountains, Jackson Lake mirrors the striking panoramas spread out before you. Lunch today is included with the afternoon free for sightseeing or horseback riding. Dinner and overnight lodging at Jackson Lake Lodge are included in the tour. John D. Rockefeller, Jr., in cooperation with the National Park Service, provided funds to build model accommodations at Jackson Lake Lodge. You live luxuriously in your cottage, each room with private bath. Sign meal checks—your meal coupon is good for \$9.01 a day for each person.

**5th Day of Vacation**—Breakfast and lunch at Jackson Lake Lodge. Morning for leisure or sightseeing at your choice. See suggestions at right. Away by bus at 2:15 pm to Grant Village Marina on Yellowstone Lake, scenic boat tour across Yellowstone Lake to Bridge Bay Marina, transfer to Lake Hotel, with arrival at 5:20 pm for dinner and overnight.

## SUGGESTED SIGHTSEEING IN TETON PARK

### 30 MILE FLOAT TRIP—

6 hours (Lv. 8:15 am—Return 2:15 pm)..\$11.00

The world and all its problems are soon far away as your float moves down the Snake River, pioneering its way around each bend into unspoiled natural grandeur. Lunch is served at Deadman's Bar prior to completing this float adventure at the foot of the magnificent Teton peaks.

### BOAT TRIP ON JACKSON LAKE—

2 hours (Lv. 8:45 am—Return 11:15 am)..\$4.80

From Colter Bay marina the modern lake cruiser heads out over Jackson Lake to the base of massive Mount Moran to give the visitor the complete impact of size—then cruises along the shore to search for elk, deer, moose—an opportunity for unusual photos. Bus to and from the marina.

From here your schedule will vary depending on route you have chosen for exit from the Park, via Cody or Red Lodge if you are returning East or South, or via Gardiner if you are continuing westbound on a transcontinental trip, via the North Coast Limited, or you can leave via Gardiner eastbound if you prefer.

## CHOOSE YOUR FAVORITE EXIT

### ■ OUT GARDINER GATEWAY

**6th Day of Vacation**—Breakfast and lunch at Lake Hotel. Lv. Lake 1:00 pm via Grand Canyon and Artist Point, with stops to see this magnificent gorge, then Mount Washburn and Tower Falls. Ar. Mammoth Motor Inn 5:00 pm. Dinner provided at Inn. Lv. Mammoth Motor Inn 7:15 pm by bus. Ar. Livingston 8:50 pm. Overnight at Murray Hotel in Livingston.

#### For Travelers West

**7th Day of Vacation**—Breakfast and lunch provided at your hotel. Lv. Livingston 1:07 pm on the Streamlined North Coast Limited. Ar. Portland 7:00 am, or Tacoma 8:25 am, Seattle 8:30 am the following morning.

#### For Travelers East

**7th Day of Vacation**—After breakfast at the Murray Hotel, Lv. Livingston 11:06 am on the North Coast Limited. Ar. St. Paul 6:40 am, Chicago 1:45 pm, first day following your departure from Livingston.

### ■ OUT SILVER GATE

**6th Day of Vacation**—After breakfast leave Lake Hotel at 8:10 am, stopping at Artist Point and Grand Canyon for views of this magnificent gorge. Continue to Mammoth Motor Inn, arriving for lunch at 11:55 am. Leave Mammoth at 3:20 pm for Silver Gate and over the spectacular Beartooth High Road. Dinner at Red Lodge. Overnight and room with bath provided at Northern Hotel in Billings.

### ■ OUT CODY ROAD

**6th Day of Vacation**—Breakfast at Lake Hotel, leave at 9:00 am for side trip to Artist Point and Grand Canyon, returning to Lake Hotel at 11:00 am. Leave Lake Hotel at 2:50 pm over famous Fishing Bridge and Thrilling Cody Road. Arrive Cody at 5:55 pm, dinner on your own at Green Gables Inn. Leave Cody at 7:15 pm by bus, arriving in Billings at 9:15 pm. Room with bath provided at the Northern Hotel.

**7th Day of Vacation**—Both for Out-Silver Gate and Out-Cody travelers a breakfast and lunch provided at Northern Hotel. Eastbound you leave Billings on the Streamlined North Coast Limited at 1:12 pm. The following day, your 8th Day of Vacation, you arrive Minneapolis 6:10 am, St. Paul 6:40 am.




*Spectacular Cody Road to Yellowstone*

■ Package rates quoted herein include tour within Yellowstone and Teton Parks as described in this itinerary, complete between entrance and exit cities, with sightseeing, hotels and meals. Above rates are figured, two persons to each hotel room without bath. Private baths are provided in hotels at Billings and Livingston and in the new cottages at Teton Park. Yellowstone's hotels have very limited numbers of private baths so private baths are not included at Mammoth, Old Faithful and Lake hotels. If accommodations with bath are reserved or confirmed in advance, additional charge must be paid at time of sale. The same arrangement applies to single rooms.

Single rooms, without private bath, are \$2.25 extra per night, and with bath \$5.75 extra per night, depending upon type of room selected. At Jackson Lake Lodge, you may have a single room by paying \$6.68 extra to cashier. Meals on trains NOT included—individual tastes vary too much—you can eat for \$7.20 per day or less in Northern Pacific diners.

Rate quotations are subject to current tariffs, and may change. **Costs from any city** may be figured by adding roundtrip rail fares, or family fares, to above tour costs, depending on exit gateway chosen.

**NOTE:** Above rates DO NOT include rail or Pullman tickets between your home city and Park gateway cities.

Family Fares apply on most railroads. Ask your local agent—you can make a substantial saving by taking advantage of the family plan.
