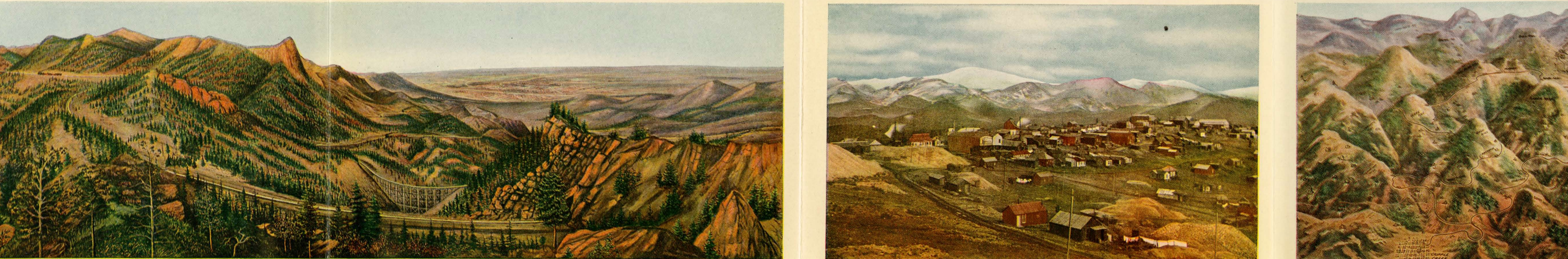
a rimmed cup in the mountain tops with towering hills of gold in its center. Out of these hills have come wealth to overlay many a proud spot of earth with glitter of gold.

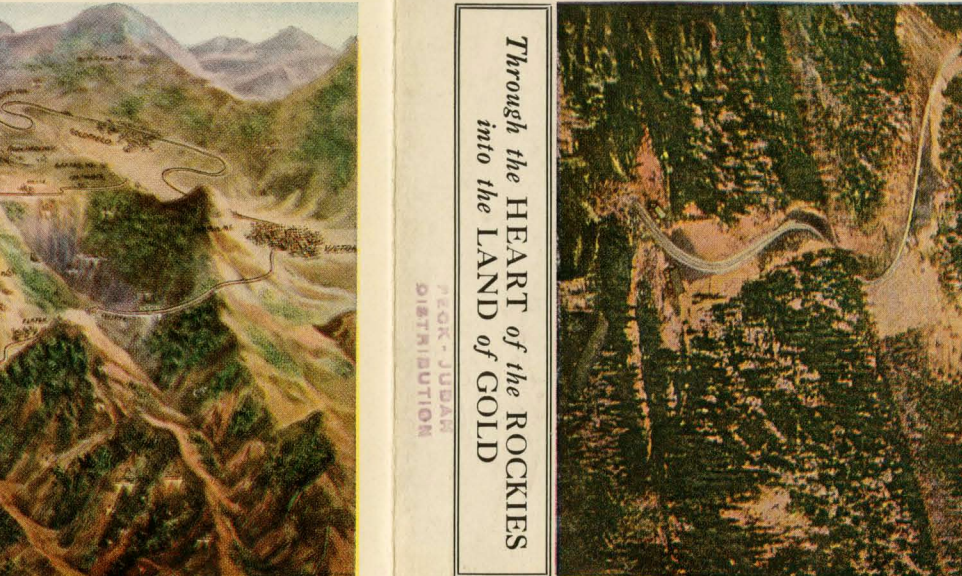

Altman, Cripple Creek District, the Highest Incorporated Town in the World—The Cripple Creek Trip

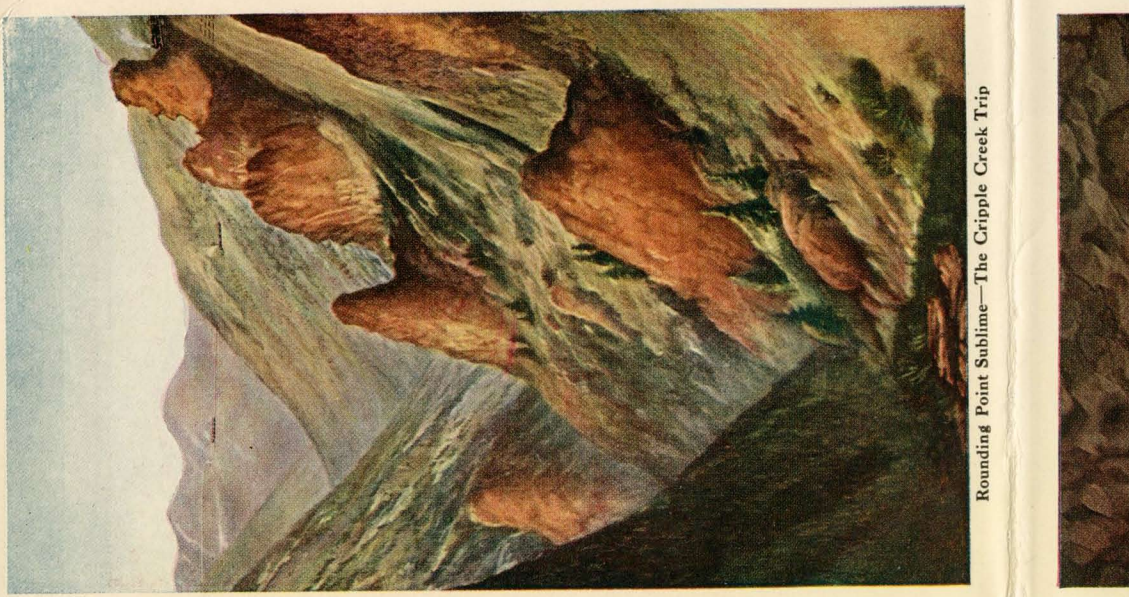


Electric Line System in The Cripple Creek District

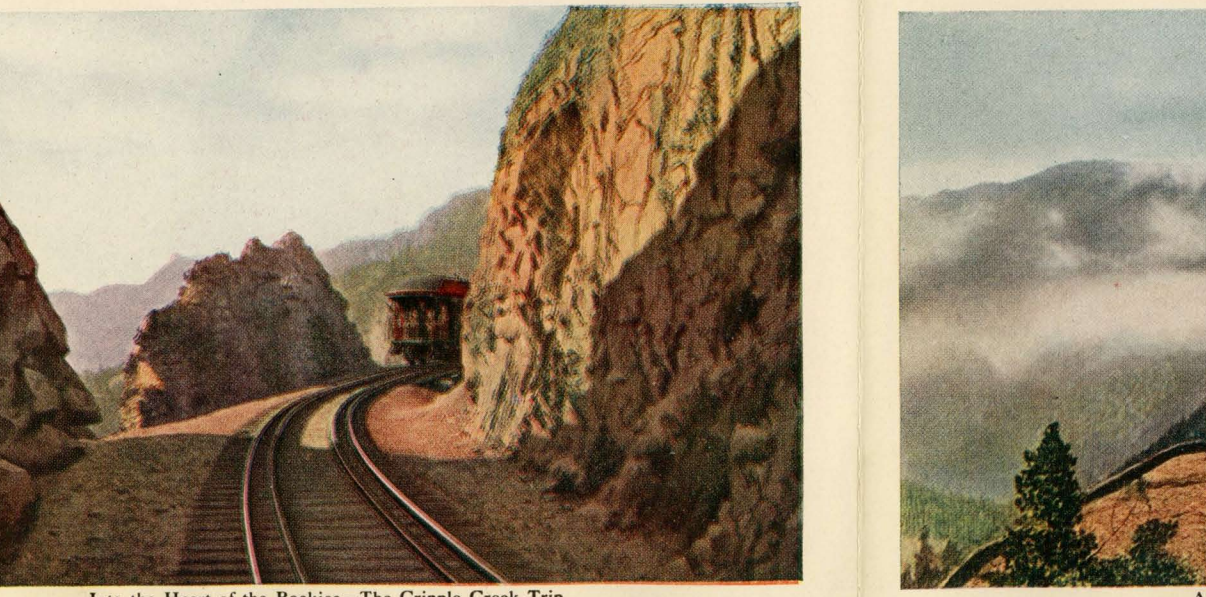

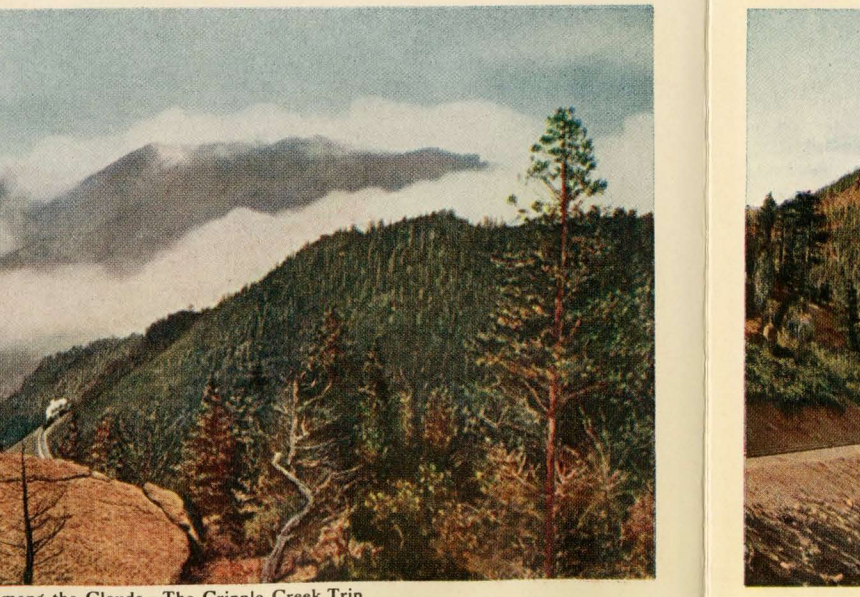

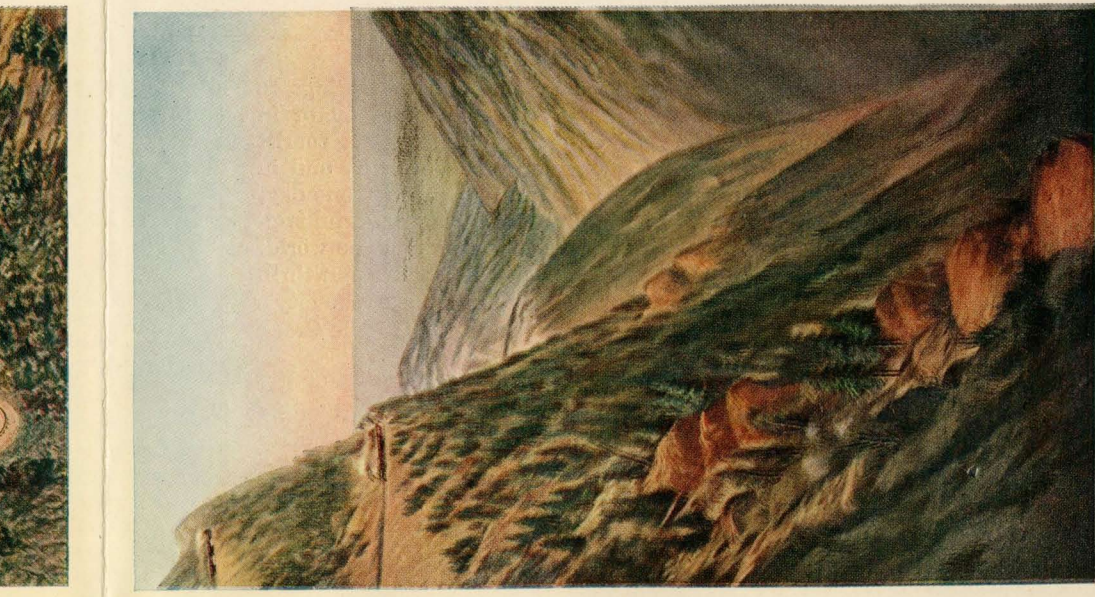
