MOFFAT TUNNEL ROUTE

Denver to Ogden 606.9 miles

Down the west slope of the continent the track parallels the Colorado river for 235 entrancing miles. The Colorado springs from the earth a gentle stream, fed by everlasting snows on sky-piercing peaks. A rippling brook, it soon becomes a restless torrent, dashing over jagged boulders through towering canyons. Great clefts like majestic Gore Canyon, longer and deeper than most mountain chasms, bear the geological history of the Rockies indelibly recorded on rugged rock walls.

The Dotsero Cutoff, a new 38-mile railroad between Orestod (Dotsero spelled backward) and Dotsero, joins the Moffat and Rio Grande railroads. At Dotero the Moffat Tunnel and Royal Gorge routes blend into a single bewitching steel speedway.






Hanging Bridge in the Royal Gorge 1053 Feet Below the World's Highest Bridge






