In Utah's Salt Lake Valley—where a century of Mormon industry and thrift has transformed a barren desert into a veritable garden spot—industry, too, is now finding a firm foothold.

As represented by the huge war-born plant of the Geneva Steel Company—pictured on the cover at the foot of Mt. Timpanogos—heavy industry is now providing the economic balance that augurs well for the future of the Intermountain Empire.

No steel plant in the world has a more beautiful setting than Geneva. The broad and fertile reaches of the Valley are surrounded by the rugged peaks of the Wasatch Range, most imposing of which is 12,008-foot Timpanogos — "sleeping princess" of Indian legend — glacier-crowned sentinel of the range.
