SOPRIS PEAK AND CRYSTAL RIVER

Stately Sopris Peak presides over the scenic vacationland of Western Colorado — on the Main Line Through the Rockies. The sparkling Crystal River is but one of a number of streams in the area known to trout fishermen the country over — such fabulous streams as the Frying Pan, the Roaring Fork, the Eagle, the White and, of course, the Colorado, to which the others are all tributary. In the region surrounding Glenwood Springs are more than 300 miles of open water, teeming with scrappy trout.

Fishing is big business in Colorado, and the state's Game and Fish Department maintains Colorado's reputation as a fishing state by planting more than four million trout every year — in crystal-clear lakes and rippling streams.

Serving the year-round recreational area surrounding Glenwood Springs are the two routes of the Denver & Rio Grande Western Railroad — that from Pueblo through the mighty Royal Gorge of the Arkansas River, and the Colorado River scenic shortcut via the Moffat Tunnel from Denver. The two routes converge at the head of Glenwood Canyon — one of the most colorful of all Colorado River gorges and fitting introduction to this play-time paradise.
