Western Pacific \$18,000,000 Improvement Program

EXTENSIVE IMPROVEMENTS in its roadway and equipment are being made by the Western Pacific in accordance with a program begun in 1927 and covering a period of about six years which will cost ultimately \$18,000,000.

This program includes the renewal of rail on main line track in California, Nevada and Utah, widening of embankments and ballasting, construction of new steel and concrete bridges, lining of tunnels with concrete, rebuilding of freight cars, etc.

Noteworthy progress has been made since the program was inaugurated as is shown by the fact that expenditures for improvements up to the beginning of this year total approximately \$5,400,000.

The importance of the improvements accomplished, in relation to the Western Pacific as an entirety, may be realized by the following:

Rail change has been effected on 185 miles or 20 per cent of the main line mileage. Ballasting has been completed on 389 miles or 42 per cent of the main line mileage. Bank widening has been done on 562 miles or 61 per cent of the main line mileage.

The improvement program is being vigorously carried forward this year
