## CROSSING GREAT SALT LAKE



The Western Pacific crosses an arm of the Great Salt Lake by a new route across the southern end of that silent sea, and a little further on enters upon the Great Salt Beds. Here for thirty miles the roadbed is laid upon white, solid salt, from one to fifteen feet thick and extending four miles on either hand.
